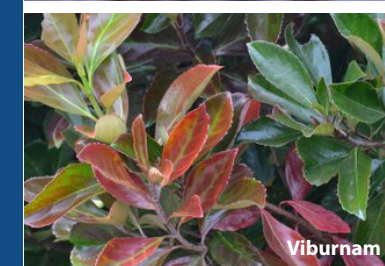


The Pollinator Berm Garden

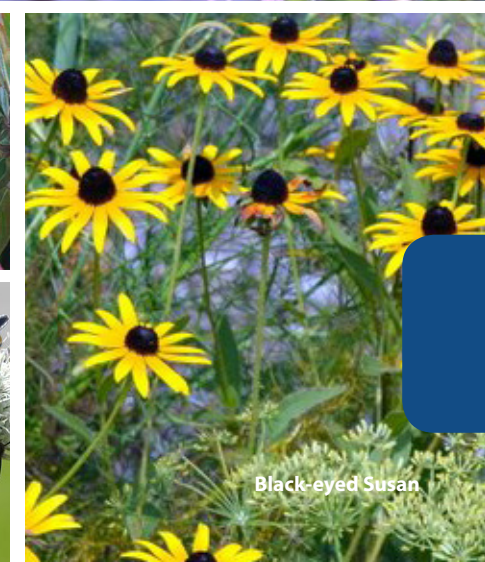

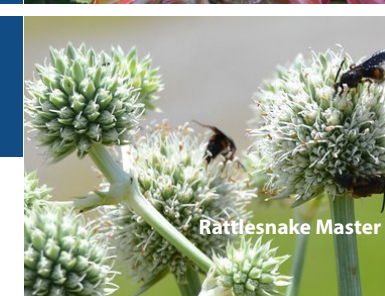
