Old Business: Mercer County Joint Seal Coat Program meeting was January 15, 2026. Bid opening to be April 16, 2026.



New Business: Coolspring Township Planning Board met January 29, 2026 and has sent a letter to the Board of Supervisors recommending data centers be added to the zoning ordinance as a conditional use in Industrial Zone only. They also discussed mining during their meeting. Ken made a motion to send a letter to Mercer County Regional Planning Commission requesting assistance to prepare Municipal Planning Code-compliant amendments to the Coolspring Township Zoning Ordinance, including new provision addressing data centers, mining and related land uses. Cory seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.




Tri-County "Clean up Day" scheduled for week of June 1, 2026. Tri-County Garbage contract is currently in a 1-year extension that ends June 30, 2026. Contract allows for 3 one-year extensions, this is the first year. Terri is to reach out to Tri-County to see if they will extend another year.

Cory made a motion to purchase road salt through COSTARS for the August 2026-July 2027 season. Ken seconded. Discussion on amount to order: Initial Fill (8/1/26– 10/31/26 -125 Tons
Winter Tons (11/1/26– 7/31/27 -125 Tons For a total of 250 Tons. Motion carried.

Having nothing further to discuss, Ken asked for a motion to adjourn. Cory made the motion. Meeting adjourned.
