Others in Attendance: 12 people signed in. Meeting was held in the rental hall.

Meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance

Mercer County Commissioner Ann Coleman talked about the reassessment process, the Lean and Green Program and radios for first responders. Dale spoke with Jon Bevic of Sunrise Solar about no mowing being done. They told him they are looking for someone local to mow.




