

ITINERARY -- 8 NIGHTS/ 9 DAYS

Agartala – Aizawl – Imphal – Kohima – Dimapur

Day 01: Arrive Agartala by air

Meet and assist and transfer to hotel. In the afternoon visit the Ujjayanta Palace, the famous royal house in the heart of the city. It is beautifully carved and sculpted in Indo-Greek style. Constructed by Maharaja Radhakishorelan Manikaya in 1901 the palace is nicely located with gardens and adorned with pools.



Day 02: Full day Agartala and surroundings

Drive 53 km to Neermahal, (Water Palace). It was built as a summer resort for the erstwhile King Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya in 1930. The Palace, situated right at the center of the Rudrasagar Lake (6 Sq Km water body) is a magnificent piece of engineering. In the afternoon we drive to Udaipur, 25 km from Neermahal – visit the revered Hindu temple of Tripura Sundari beside the lake Kalyan Sagar. Return to Agartala. Overnight.

Day 03: Fly Agartala – Aizawl

Arrive Aizawl airport, transfer to hotel. Evening at Bara Bazar, a traditional local market.

Day 04: Full day Aizawl, Reik village

Drive to Reik village a short distance from Aizawl. Spend the day walking along its pathways looking at Mizo way of life. Return to Aizawl in the afternoon and visit the Solomon Temple. Overnight.

Day 05: Fly Aizawl to Imphal

Meet and assist at the airport and transfer to hotel. Afternoon visit the revered Shree Govindajee Temple. From here drive to the 'Ima' or all-mothers market where you can see Manipuri women selling traditional wares – from clothes to utensils and many other items.



Day 06: Imphal



We will head to Loktak Lake, this is one of India's largest and most beautiful freshwater lakes with great views on offer from atop Sendra Island. The lake has floating islands and local fishermen make a living catching fish by navigating around in their small rowing boats. You can hire motorized boats to sail in the lake at an extra cost.

Return to Imphal and visit the Kangla Fort, situated close to the banks of the Imphal River. It is a symbol of Manipur's glory. Kangla was the ancient capital of Manipur and a number of Meitei monarchs ruled the destination from this fort. The fort holds immense archaeological, religious and historical significance. There is also a museum inside its grounds.

Day 07 (18 Mar 2022): Drive to Kohima, 147 km/ 5 hours

Check into hotel. Afternoon visit the 2nd World War cemetery of the Allied forces. From here walk to the nearby local market where you can see villagers selling a host of vegetables, herbs and even worms and caterpillars that are a delicacy to the local populace.

Day 08: Kohima – Khonoma – Kohima, 20 km one way

A day trip to Khonoma, the van guard village of the Angami Nagas. This village has the pride of never being subjugated by any outside force. Today it is drawing accolades for another reason – going green. Walk in the neat pathways of the village looking out to terraced cultivation that grows twenty variety of rice. Return to Kohima and visit Kisama heritage village and the nearby WW 2 museum.

Day 09: Kohima – Dimapur airport, 74 KM, 2 hours

Drive down to Dimapur airport to board your outgoing flight.
