

# NFPA CERTIFICATION PREREQUISITES

## Application for certificate must be received within 2 years of completed evaluation.

#### NOTE:

- Medical qualifications: Proof of minimum current certification in Standard First Aid with CPR "C" must be provided with application. If the first aid training is from one of the training providers approved by Alberta OHS for first aid training in the workplace, it will be accepted with no additional documentation. If the training is from another provider, then documentation will be required to demonstrate how that training meets the medical requirements in the relevant NFPA standard.
- All credentials obtained outside Alberta must be submitted with application.
- Prior to acquiring a higher-level certificates, all lower-level prerequisite certificates must be obtained.
- Required Incident Command System (ICS) prerequisites must be completed.
