



MEN'S DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS SUPPORT GROUP

In a men's domestic violence awareness support group, men share what they are going through in a calm, confidential and trusting environment. What happens in the group stays in the group! These groups are led by an experienced men's domestic violence group facilitator who helps by listening and giving resolutions to whatever is shared in the group. The facilitator can also link the participants with the more specific support services and programs or specialized domestic violence services if need be.

1 in 7 men age 18 and older have experienced domestic violence by an intimate partner. Nearly 8% of males who have reported domestic violence have been shot at, stabbed or hit with a weapon.
