

Our first stop was Ubirr with its splendid collection of rock art and spectacular views of the Kakadu plains from the Nadab Lookout. Next was a cruise on the East Alligator River run by an aboriginal group - a most informative and enjoyable experience with the guides showing off their knowledge of the area and crocodile spotting skills. We briefly stepped out onto Arnhem Land and on our return down the river we saw the "Homer" rock. Lastly a fairly quick look around the Bowali Visitor Centre near Jabiru and then back to Darwin.
