We had an early ride to Seisia where we left John to drive the bus back to Cairns while we headed across the Endeavour Strait and past Prince of Wales Island to...





















Day 3 Cape Tribulation, Bloomfield Track, Cooktown 🗦














Day 7 Bauxite Mine, Batavia Downs, Moreton Telegraph Station

































Day 8 Moreton Telegraph Station









Day 12 Thursday Island, Horn Island, Cairns


