We walked through the old Gothic Quarter of Barcelona with its narrow streets trying to avoid the demonstrators on our way to the Barcelona Cathedral. The...



Our small-bus tour took us north out of Barcelona past the rugged Montserrat and stopping at the small Catalan town of Barga for coffee. Continuing north we...








