PRE-TOURNAMENT MANAGERS MEETING

Mandatory managers meeting will be conducted via ZOOM on Wednesday July 2nd at 7 pm Central time zone.

PRACTICE FIELDS

Teams may use the batting cages at the main fields (see map attached)

RULES

All official Little League rules that apply will be strictly enforced. **Our local rules** include no smoking, tobacco use, or vaping at all outdoor facilities.





PRE-GAME PROCEDURE

- As soon as both teams arrive at the field, get with the tournament director for the coin flip.
- At 30 minutes prior to game time, the visiting team will take the field for 10 minutes of infield.
- At 20 minutes prior to game time, the home team will take the field for 10 minutes of infield.
- Managers will then meet with the umpires for the pregame conference.
- Then players will be introduced and will line up behind their respective foul lines, team announcemnts and National Anthem.

DETERMINING HOME TEAM

Under tournament rules, the home team is determined by a coin toss. The coin toss will be done by the tournament director/coordinator assigned to your game as soon as both managers arrive at the field. Home team may choose which dugout they want to use.

EQUIPMENT

Each team should bring sufficient equipment to cover their needs. St Bethlehem Little League will have some equipment available in case of an emergency. There are local and national sporting goods stores in the area if the need arises.

CONCESSION STAND

A full-service concession stand will be open for the duration of the tournament. We accept cash and cards.
