

## Schedule









### **Tournament Format**

The tournament is double elimination. There may be double headers on the schedule due to weather. The tournament bracket will be sent to you shortly. Games will start shortly after opening ceremony.

### Rules

All official Little League Tournament Baseball and Softball rules will apply and will be strictly enforced.

### Food

Concession stands will be open and available each day.

### **Determining Home Team**

### Arrive 60 minutes prior to the start of your posted game.

Little League Tournament Baseball rules require that the home team be determined by a coin toss prior to each game. The Tournament Director or Head Umpire will be responsible for the coin toss to be attended by each team's Manager.



### Lineups:

Your lineup must be completed and turned into the appropriate press box no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of your game (even if the game before yours is running late). The lineup must legibly include each player's name, uniform number and starting position. The lineup must also include the names of the Manager and all assistant coaches as they will be introduced prior to the start of the game. If any player or coach has a unique name, please tell the PA announcer the correct pronunciation.

### Player introductions, National Anthem and Little League Pledge:

10 minutes before game time the PA announcer will introduce players, coaches and umpires. Players and coaches will assemble on their respective baseline as they are announced and remain on the line for the National Anthem and Little League Pledge.

Following the Little League Pledge, Managers will immediately meet with the umpires at home plate for the pregame conference, after which the game will begin.





### **Tournament Umpires:**

Please remember the umpires are volunteers. They are graciously donating their time and efforts for your team. As such we insist that players, coaches and fans always show sportsmanship and fair play.

### **Equipment:**

Each team should bring only Little League-approved equipment. Umpires will check equipment prior to the start of every game. If equipment does not meet Little League standard of play, equipment will be removed and secured. Equipment will be returned at the end of team's participation in tournament.

### Safety:

- Please do not warm up your team outside of a field (in common areas) for safety purposes.

- No swinging bats outside of the cages or fields When you arrive at the park for your game, please let Kody know you are on-site. Once both coaches are on-site we will do a coin flip to determine home/away. Please match the scoreboard in accordance to which dugout is home and away. Home 1st base/ Away 3rd base.

    - o Pool party from 6:15pm-8:15pm @ Beachaven Pool beside the ballpark
    - o Home Run Derby starting at 7:00 for up to 3 players from each team.

### Saturday though the end of the tournament

o \$5 parking- cash this will be done at the parks entry gate after you park)

### No coolers please. (Coaches allowed 1 cooler for teams) there will be a water cooler in the dugouts as well.

- o Please do not hang anything on the spectator safety netting. Chain link is fine
- Our fields and park is privately maintained by volunteers. This allows us the ability to work the fields and get them playable in case the rain decides to fall.
