

Additional Information

A full service concession stand will be open for the duration of the tournament. We accept both cash and debit/credit.

State Tournament shirts will be available while supplies last.

Parking will be \$10/day per vehicle or you will have the option to purchase a parking pass for the duration of the tournament for \$30. CASH ONLY!

Managers- If your team would like to preorder parking passes, please text the Tournament Director and she will have those ready for you during the managers meeting.

We will have a professional photographer onsite during the tournament and will be taking pictures throughout. A link to those pictures will be available for parents to purchase.

All games will be played on Field 3.

Practice Fields: Field 5 along with our batting cages will be available and will be on a first come first serve basis.

Tournament format: double elimination.

Please arrive 60 minutes prior to the start of your posted game.

Lineups: Your lineup must be completed and turned into the press box no later than 30 minutes prior to the schedule start of your game (even if the game before yours is running late.) The lineup must include each players name, uniform number, and starting position. If any player has a unique name, please tell the announcer the correct pronunciation.

Determining Home Team: Under tournament rules, home team is determined by a coin toss. The coin toss will be done by the tournament director or head umpire. Home team will occupy the first base dugout.

Pre-game Procedure: As soon as both teams arrive at the field, get with the tournament director for the coin flip. At 30 minutes prior to game time, the visiting team will take the field for 10 minutes of infield. At 20 minutes prior to game time, the home team will take the field for 10 minutes of infield. At 10 minutes to game time, players will line up behind their respective foul lines to be introduced and recite the Little League Pledge. Managers will then meet with the umpires for the Pre-game conference.

Rules: All official Little League Tournament Baseball rules will apply and be strictly enforced.

Equipment: Each team should bring only Little League approved equipment. Umpires will check equipment prior to the start of every game. If equipment does not meet Little League standard of play, equipment will be removed and secured. Equipment will be returned at the end of each team's participation in the tournament.
