SPIRITUAL WARFARE WINNING THE BATTLES PART 3 (RECAP)

Focus Scripture...

"No man is going to stand before you all the days of your life. As I was with Mashah, so I am with you. I do not fail you nor forsake you. Be strong and courageous, for you are to let this people inherit the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous, to guard to do according to all the Turah which Mashah My servant commanded you. Do not turn from it right or left, so that you act wisely wherever you go. Do not let this Book of the Turah depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night so that you guard to do according to all that is written in it. For then you shall make your way prosperous, and act wisely."

Strongholds Begin in the Mind

Yahuah has provided a clear plan to keep us from strongholds. We must...

- Walk in Obedience
- Have the Mind of the Ruach of Yah and Wisdom
- Pray & Fast Consistently
- Praise & Rejoice at all Times
- Work in the Calling Yahuah has on Your Life

"I will keep him (or her) in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on Me." – YashaYahu 26:3

"Be you transformed by the renewing of your mind so that you prove the good, perfect, and acceptable will of Yahuah." Ramym 12:2

"As a man (or woman) thinks so is he (or she)." Mashaly 23:7

"Work while it is day for the night is coming when no one will work." Yahanan 9:4

"When the prince of this world comes, he wil.;'l find nothing in me." Yahanan 14:30

"Rejoice always..." Philipians 4:4 - A woman who is doing as this verse says, "rejoicing always" will not be cast down and will not be a subject to strongholds. When we are cast down or discouraged many may seek happiness and peace by means that are outside of the will of Yahuah. Rejoicing paves the way for overcoming. The daughter of Yahuah will be an overcomer, a victorious child of Yahuah preparing herself for Kingdom Entrance.

Whose Table Are You Eating From?

"You can't drink both a cup of the Lord and a cup of demons, you can't partake in both a meal of Yahuah and a meal of demons." 1 Corinthians 10:21

It is important that we are aware of the table we are eating from. There are many voices out there, and many people have or feel they have something to say. However, there are a few questions we, especially as women of Yah, should ask ourselves before we partake of someone's table.

- What is the message? What does this person want me to receive/believe?
- Is this person serving Yahuah?
- Is this person known to be involved in the occult and realm of witchcraft?
- Does this person have a reputation of consistent sin in his or her life?
- Does the spirit of Yah in me bear witness that this person is of Yah or is pursing righteousness?

Then there are some questions we must ask ourselves about ourselves.

- Have I sought Yahuah about the subject matter I am investigating?
- Have I talked about it or studied it with my assembly circle, or for those who are married Have I talked about this with my spouse? Does he agree with me listening to this individual?
- Is this a distraction? Is there something else Yah means for me to do or that I should be doing instead of using this time to partake from a stranger's table?

Aware of Behaviors and Habits

If we find ourselves in a constant state of behavior that is contrary to the nature of Yahuah and to Wisdom, then, it is an indication that the Set-apart Spirit is either operating at a low level or is absent all together. We then go humbly to Yahuah, with the admissions that, "I need You, Yah, please fill my cup."

Yahuah wants us to see Him and His esteem workings each day that we live. It is offensive to our Redeemer and heavenly Father, when our behaviors and habits do not reflect Him and His goodness. Considering all Yahuah has done for us, what manner of people should we be? We should be rejoicing always, "...and again I say rejoice." Philippians 4:4.

We know that we face challenges and there are those who will reject us for our commitment to the Turah of Yahuah. Yet, we can take great joy knowing that our Father has not rejected us. Think about it. Yahuah is daily rejected by His own children, many who started this journey end up telling Him, "No," somewhere down the line, or there are those who say, "No," the moment the Spirit of Yah tugs at their heart or someone brings truth to them. However, Yahuah does not stop performing for the rest of the children who are remaining faithfully in His house. What manner of people should we be? Praise Yah!
