

This week we will be looking at the last fruits in this study. These two fruits of the Spirit are taken from the Book of Yashayahu (Isaiah) 11:1-2: "And a Rod shall come forth from the stump of Yishai... *The Spirit of Yahuah shall rest on him*. The Spirit of wisdom and understanding..." We may or may not be from the seed of Yishai, but we are of the seed of Yahuah. For we have been brought forth by the seed of His Word and His Set-apart Spirit. That being said, having wisdom and understanding is a MUST. We live in a world that has been stripped of understanding. People do not know what is right. Truth has fallen in the streets, and right cannot enter. However, Mashaly (Proverbs) 28:2b states, "...by a man of understanding and knowledge, right is maintained." We can see from this Book of Wisdom how important it is to have understanding. If we don't have understanding there isn't any way we will have the wisdom to make good decisions. "Does not wisdom call, and understanding lift up her voice? O men, I call to you...understand insight...be of an understanding heart." Mashaly 8:1-5. It is imperative that we understand the deception of the beastly system with all its tentacles. The religious, economic, political, medical, and the social arms of this system has made people void of understanding Yahuah's purpose for humankind; therefore, there isn't correct knowledge of their Creator. Ephesians 1:18 states, "...the Father of esteem, would give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him (Yahuah), the eyes of your understanding being enlightened, so that you know what is the expectation of His calling, and what are the riches of His inheritance in the set-apart ones."

As set-apart people of Yahuah we must realize what He expects of us. We must understand the esteem of the inheritance that will be ours if we are steadfast to the end. Once we realize this we will have the wisdom to turn away from the evil of this world. "See the fear of Yahuah, that is wisdom, and to turn from evil is understanding." Iyob (Job) 28:28.
