TECHNICAL SUPPORT

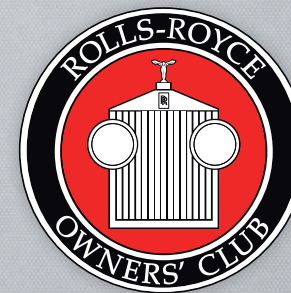
