This program focuses on strengthening families by providing supportive services. The ROSS Service Coordinator will assist the participant by finding the right resources in the community such as job Training, employment, child care, housing, education and assistance with food or clothing.

The ROSS program promotes the idea of reducing the need for welfare assistance and assists the participant in making progress toward achieving economic independence and self sufficiency. By utilizing a combination of community resources the participant can accomplish their individual goals.

ROSS also includes supportive services for individuals with disabilities and the elderly, who will be capable to age-in-place.

The ROSS Service Coordinator will link RHA residents with training opportunities, partner with job placement organizations and local employers. Family members who are sixteen (16) year of age and older residing in the same household are strongly encouraged to participate in the ROSS program. Family members can be connected with funding sources including scholarships and other type of assistance and activities.
