- At the end of the exhibition, visiting artists will take their paintings home.
- It is the responsibility of the visiting artists to arrange and cover the cost of shipping their paintings back.
- Visiting artists have the option to sell their artwork during the exhibition; otherwise, the paintings will be displayed for exhibition purposes only
