Since joining the gallery in 2023 as Art Liaison, Mack has played an integral role in shaping the gallery's artist relations, curatorial programming, and community engagement initiatives. Her leadership and dedication have contributed significantly to the gallery's continued growth and cultural impact within the contemporary art landscape.

Known for her commitment to amplifying artists of the African Diaspora, Mack's work extends beyond curation into public programming, cultural advocacy, and collector engagement. Throughout her time at Tanya Weddemire Gallery, she has worked closely alongside Tanya Weddemire to cultivate meaningful relationships between artists, collectors, and audiences while helping to expand the gallery's visibility through exhibitions, activations, and partnerships rooted in accessibility and representation.

As Art Liaison, Curator, and Advisor, Mack has remained committed to uplifting her community through innovative vision, advocacy for emerging artists, and a deep alignment with the gallery's three core pillars: Community, Culture, and Legacy.

Mack's appointment marks an exciting new chapter for both her personal growth and the gallery as it continues its mission of advocating for emerging and established contemporary artists. Her leadership has strengthened the gallery's commitment to inclusive storytelling and innovative programming while fostering dialogue that utilizes art as a conduit for education, inspiration, and cultural preservation for future generations.

In addition to overseeing artist relations and gallery operations, Mack has curated two notable exhibitions presented at Tanya Weddemire Gallery: **I Got a Story to Tell (2025)** and **Making Something Out Of Nothing (2026)**. Her curatorial practice centers original storytelling, intergenerational dialogue, and the resourcefulness embedded within Black cultural production.

Prior to becoming Director, Mack led initiatives in collaboration with organizations including Black Girls in Art Spaces, A Place Called Home, and Industry City. Her contributions and work have been featured in PIX11, HelloBeautiful, Brooklyn Paper, BK Reader, Park Magazine, and SeeGreatArt. She has also participated in public conversations and panels with the Fashion Institute of Technology Black Student Union, Howard University Chadwick A. Boseman College of Fine Arts, and the ABLE Initiative.

Mack has traveled and participated with the gallery in several major international art fairs including SCOPE Art Show, EXPO Chicago, and 1-54 Contemporary African Art Fair, among others.

In 2025, Mack received her Certificate in Contemporary Art History from Sotheby's Institute of Art and continues to build an arts practice centered around accessibility, cultural impact, and artistic visibility.

Tanya Weddemire Gallery is a Brooklyn-based contemporary art gallery, established in 2022 and located in Industry City, Brooklyn. Founded by Tanya Weddemire, the gallery is dedicated to presenting the work of emerging and established artists whose practices explore identity, heritage, and contemporary narratives. Through thoughtful curatorial programming and strong community engagement, the gallery presents exhibitions, artist projects, and collaborations that connect cultural and historical perspectives with current artistic practices. Its programming is also supported by philanthropic initiatives that reinforce the gallery's commitment to cultural access and impact. Exhibitions highlight a range of medium including painting, sculpture, and mixed media allowing artists to communicate layered stories and lived experiences through material and form. Tanya Weddemire Gallery has presented artists through both in gallery exhibitions and international art fairs, including SCOPE Miami Beach, EXPO Chicago, 1-54 African Contemporary Art Fair, Hamptons Fine Art Fair, Art on Paper, Atlanta Art Fair and the Affordable Art Fair. Anchored in the philosophy of community, culture, and legacy, the gallery remains committed to building meaningful connections between artists, collectors, and global audiences.
