

LIFE MEMBERSHIP POLICY

The Ormond Junior Football Club bestows Life Membership on worthy and deserving individuals who have rendered outstanding voluntary commitment and service to the Club well beyond that of a typical member. It is not necessary for life memberships to be awarded every year.

Eligibility

The nominee must be a current or past member of the Ormond Junior Football Club.

Assessment

The current committee of the Ormond Junior Football Club from time to time shall constitute a Life Membership Sub-Committee. This Sub-Committee shall meet as designated to consider nominees for Life Membership in accordance with the above criteria.

Any recommendations from that Sub Committee are to be made to the Committee of Management for consideration and approval

Criteria

The following criteria should be addressed when nominating a candidate

The key elements that will be taken into account in awarding Life Membership will be evaluated within the following guide lines.

- The nominee has been conspicuously seen by the members in their execution of duties or voluntary work towards the betterment of the club.
- The time has been substantial as measured by the number of years involved, amount of time and effort, quality of results and benefit to club and to members / football. As a guide a period of no less than 7 years ought to be considered as a minimum period of service.
- The character, personal standing and behaviour of the nominated person shall be beyond reproach.
- The nominee shall demonstrate commitment to the principals of the clubs Statement of Purpose: The purposes of the Ormond Junior Football Club Incorporated are:
 - as a member of the South Metro Junior Football League to encourage, promote, foster and develop participation in AFL, particularly in Ormond and the surrounding region
 - to teach the basic skills and fundamentals of junior football, and through this to teach, encourage and develop a sense of fair play and discipline that contributes to the overall development of young people in the local area
 - support the Ormond Amateur Football Club Incorporated (OAFC) and to work with the OAFC to provide a pathway for OJFC players into senior football.
 - to generate a welcoming and supportive club and community environment (including the provision of suitable amenities and facilities) in which all members, supporters and residents can freely participate and which supports a sense of belonging for all those involved.
- Valued leadership and good role modelling that reflects credit upon the Club.
- Contributions to the Ormond Junior Football Club which have enhanced its standing within its membership and the wider community

It is helpful to include examples of how the nominee has gone above and beyond what could reasonably be expected of a member and why their contribution is worthy of recognition through life membership of the Club.
