<p>Architect: Plan and design houses, factories, office buildings and other structures.</p> <p>Education level: bachelor's degree</p> <p>Median income: \$88,470</p>	<p>Teacher: Teach academic lessons such as math, reading, and science in order to prepare students for life after graduation.</p> <p>Education level: bachelor's degree</p> <p>Median income: \$62,000</p>	<p>Police officer: Protect lives and property.</p> <p>Education level: Range from a high school diploma to a college degree (Associates). Police training academy.</p> <p>Median income: \$77,960</p>
<p>Accountant: Keep track of a company's money; prepare budgets, reports, and monitor finances. Managers look at the accountants' reports to see how well their company is doing.</p> <p>Education Level: bachelor's degree.</p> <p>Median income: \$81,000</p>	<p>Firefighter: Control and put out fires and respond to emergencies where life, property, or the environment is at risk.</p> <p>Education level: High school diploma and training in emergency medical services.</p> <p>Median income: \$59,080</p>	<p>Human Resource Manager: Plan, direct, and coordinate the administrative functions of an organization. Oversee recruitment, interviewing, and hiring of new staff; and serve as a link between organizations management and its employees.</p> <p>Education level: bachelor's degree</p> <p>Median income: \$ 110,120</p>
<p>Nurse: Registered nurses or RNs take care of sick and injured people. They give medicine, treat wounds, and give emotional support to patients.</p> <p>Education level: Complete an accredited nursing program, followed by obtaining a license in their state of practice.</p> <p>Median Income: \$86,000</p>	<p>Doctor: Treats injuries and sick patients. Doctors examine patients, find out about patients' medical histories, and give medications and aid.</p> <p>Education Level: bachelor's degree, attending medical school for four years, and then completing a residency program, which can range from 3-7 years, depending on the specialty.</p> <p>Median Income: \$200,000.</p>	<p>Electrician: Install, maintain, and repair electrical power, communications, lighting, and control systems in homes, businesses, and factories.</p> <p>Education level: High school degree or equivalent</p> <p>Median income: \$54,110</p>



<p>Civil Engineer: design things like roads, buildings, airports, tunnels, dams, bridges, or water supply and sewage systems</p> <p>Education level: bachelor's degree</p> <p>Median income: \$84,770</p>	<p>Paralegal: Support lawyers by conducting legal research and drafting documents.</p> <p>Education level: Associates degrees and/or certificate of completion</p> <p>Median income: \$60,410</p>	<p>Software Developer: apply computer science, engineering, and math to design, develop and test software systems.</p> <p>Education level: bachelor's degree</p> <p>Median income: \$133,080</p>
<p>Social Worker: Help people solve and cope with problems in their everyday lives. Clinical social workers also diagnose and treat mental, behavioral, and emotional issues.</p> <p>Education level: bachelor's degree</p> <p>Median income: \$61,980</p>	<p>Lawyer: Advise and represent individuals, businesses, and government agencies on legal issues and disputes.</p> <p>Education level: Bachelor's degree, a Juris Doctor (JD) from an accredited law school, and to pass the bar exam</p> <p>Median income: \$155,250</p>	<p>Business and Finance Manager: produce financial reports, direct investment activities, and develop strategies and plans for the long-term financial goals of their organization.</p> <p>Education level: bachelor's degree</p> <p>Median income: \$125,080</p>
<p>Computer Programmer: Write and test code that allows computer applications and software to function properly. They turn the program designs created by software developers and engineers into instructions that a computer can follow.</p> <p>Education level: associate's degree and/or Certification</p> <p>Median income: \$90,240</p>	<p>Dental Hygienists Clean teeth, examine patients for signs of oral diseases, and provide preventive dental care.</p> <p>Education level: associate's degree</p> <p>Median income: \$74,070</p>	<p>Graphic Designer: Create visual concepts, using computer software or by hand, to communicate ideas that inspire, inform, and captivate consumers.</p> <p>Education level: bachelor's degree</p> <p>Median income: \$53,700</p>
