Please know that you and your family are in my daily prayers.

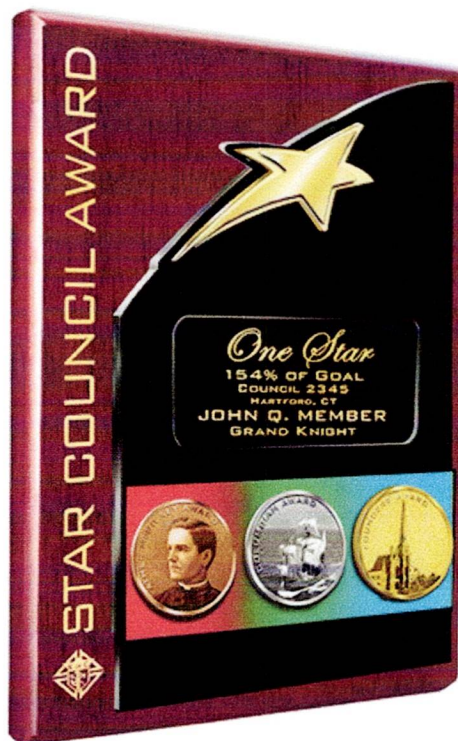

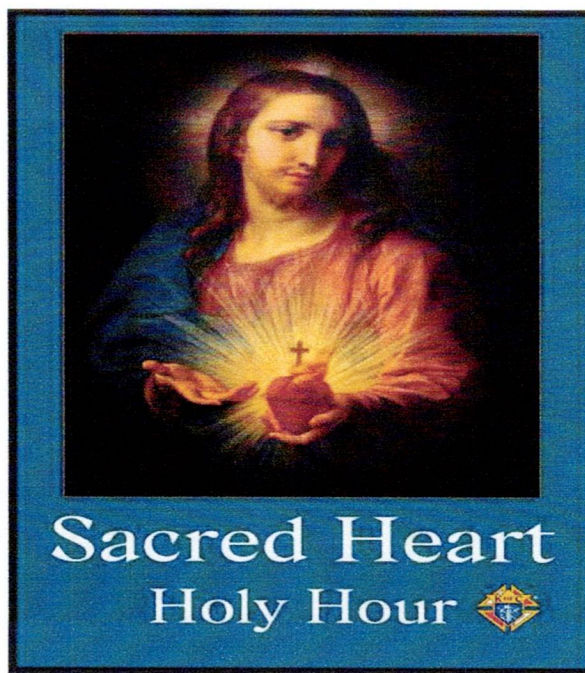

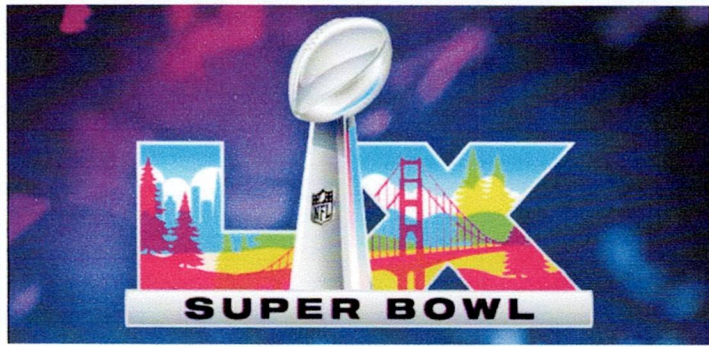
