Dear Brother Knights,

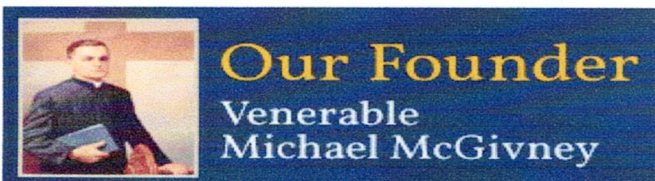
