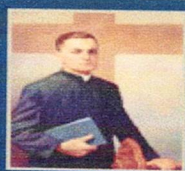
May we strive as Knights to make a difference, may we strive to live our faith in Jesus Christ.

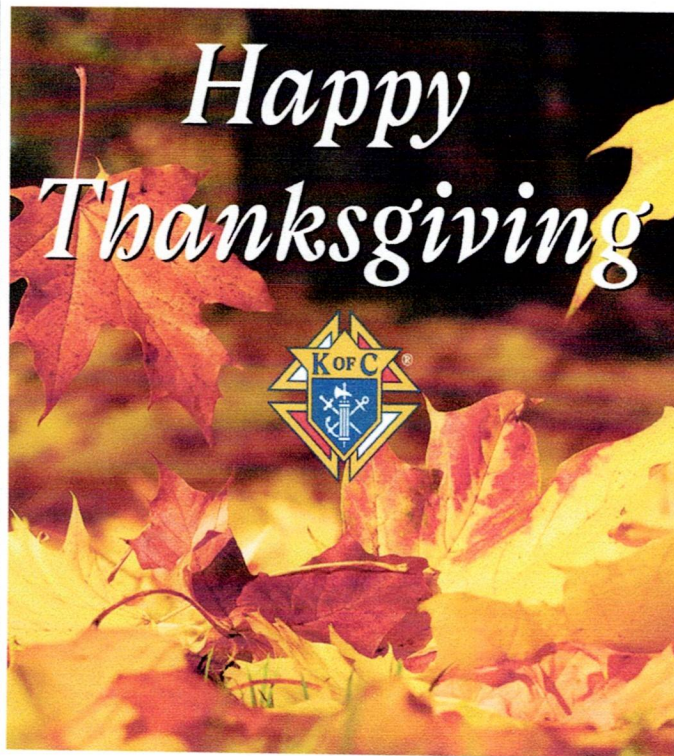

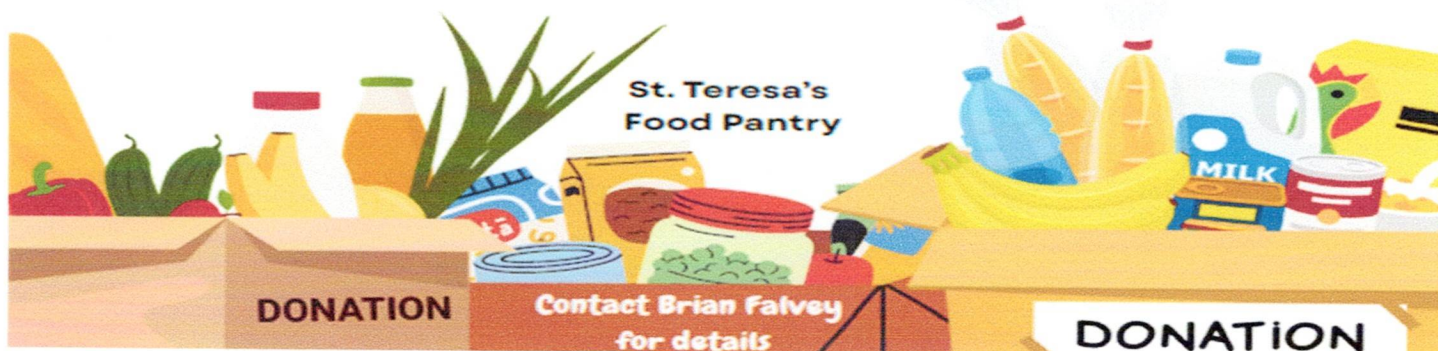
