Dear Brother Knights,

Please God, we are coming to an end of the Covid-19 pandemic. These past two years have been very challenging, and we remember all those who have died, especially our brother knights and the families of this council. We also continue to pray for those who were sick and may still not be fully recovered yet.

As we prepare to start our Lenten journey on Ash Wednesday, we have an opportunity to deepen our Catholic faith. Lent is a time of preparation: through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving (charity). The Knights of Columbus are known worldwide as being a fraternal organization of Catholic Men who live their faith, as we have clearly seen during the pandemic.

What can we as members of Council 3701 George Hudson, and as individuals, do this lent? There are many options, but allow me to suggest a few possibilities. First, I would encourage each of you to see if there are any opportunities to bring a family member or friend to Mass, especially a person who may have been away from the Church. May the example of Venerable Michael McGivney continue to guide the work of our council. Please know that you and your family are in my daily prayers.


HONORARY LIFE MEMBER DUES


