About the PNRL



First established in 2011, the Philippine National Rugby League became the first Asian nation to obtain a national world ranking in the sport of rugby league winning multiple international games played in Thailand, Philippines and Australia. This growth continued through the domestic competition which was first played in Luzon in 2016.

In 2020, the Philippine National Rugby League was restructured and **PAMBANSANG RAGBI LIGA NG PILIPINAS, INC.(PNRL)** was created and is the official governing body of Rugby League Football in the Philippines. The PNRL is a non-profit volunteer registered organization and a recognised member of the Philippine Olympic Committee and the Philippine Sports Commission. The PNRL focus is the promotion, development, and efficient administration of Rugby League in the Philippines, and to build a global following of our brand. The Philippines is a member of rugby League governing bodies, the Asia-Pacific Rugby League Confederation (APRLC) and an observer member of the International Rugby League (IRL).

As of January 2024, the Philippines (Tamaraw's) Men's National team are #23 in the IRL world ranking, and the Philippine (Sampaguitas) Women's National team at #14, both teams are the highest ranked team amongst the Asian nations.

- 2. **Domestic Games/Events** Providing more opportunities for home grown players by growing the domestic competition each year and providing opportunities for national team representation.
- 3. Finance and Administration PNRL domestic growth and development will not be possible without the support and backing of the Philippines sport's governing bodies and sponsorship. Philippine 9's Tournament

Aim of the tournament is to increase growth and participation of the sport in the Philippines, by introducing a faster, less impacting version of the game in a short time frame.

Rugby League 9's has been played in the Philippines since 2017, the Manila Storm have been the most victorious in this tournament.

As part of the growth plans, an International 9's tournament is in planning for the near future.









City vs Province Rugby League

An opportunity for local players to represent their hometowns. Eligability will be based on place of birth.

Philippines rugby league community has a big following of State of Origin with majority in support of the maroons. City vs Province will provide domestic players the chance to play like their rugby league Origin hero's.

Top performing players in this event gives them a better chance to be selected for the Philippine XIII who will play for the Presidents Cup against Hong Kong RL.







Hong Kong Vs Philippines

The purpose of this event is to simply growing and develop the game domestically in both countries.

The President's Cup allows players to strive for the opportunity to represent their country by performing during the domestic season.

We aim to attract players from both codes to assist with increase participation and attract sponsorship and funding to grown the tournament.

| Rugby League development sessions (Seniors/Juniors) | A key initiative for home grown player development, the PNRL will schedule 2x development sessions per month over the course of January to July, with further sessions scheduled from September to December. |
| 2. PNRL Domestic Competition | The PNRL Domestic competition is the official rugby league competition of the Philippines. The current foundation teams including 2 new clubs will form the 5x team competition for 2024. 2 rounds per month from July to Oct with two finals round. |
| 3. City vs Province | A version of NSW City vs Country. City v Provence will provide opportunities for domestic player selection into these two teams. Player eligibility will be based on birthplace, and is open to both Rugby codes |
| 4. Hong Kong Residents vs Philippine XIII's | End of year Mens and Womens match to further promote and grow the game. Opportunity for domestic players to earn selection into the Philippines XII's team. |
