What is MORF? (Men Of Rhinelander Faith)

MORF is a group of Christian men (non-denominational) who connect, encourage, support and equip men in our community.

Who is MORF?

MORF developed from a men's bible study group of six who believe God may have a bigger vision for the group that can impact our community more broadly. This group represents the current MORF Steering Committee.

Vision:

To impact the greater Rhinelander community through a biblical worldview.

Mission:

To establish a group of Christian, faith-centered men who seek to grow in, and live out Christ likeness in their families, workplaces, and within our community.

How will MORF make this happen?

- Unite the business community of Christian men throughout the greater Rhinelander area
- Monthly luncheon meetings are the primary vehicle for bringing these Christian men together
- *Establish a Christian men's network that shares principles from the Bible on Christ likeness, that inspires and supports one another, and builds a unique bond that enriches individual lives*
- Encouraging involvement within the greater Rhinelander community (and Oneida County) where individuals can have a tangible Kingdom impact

MORF is biblically minded:

- We acknowledge Jesus Christ as the only way of salvation (John 14:6)
- Christ is our cornerstone; plans and initiatives are Christ-influenced (Eph 2:19-22)
- The Holy Bible provides the foundation for our messages, teaching, conversation and fellowship (John 15:5)
- MORF is intended to augment church attendance and participation, not replace it (Rom 12:5)
- MORF is denomination neutral—we are a group of Christ lovers and followers (1 Cor. 2:2)
- We help fulfill the great commission by equipping Christian men in our community to promote a biblical worldview within the community (2 Tim. 2:15)
