All permanent cosmetic procedures are semi permanent and require touch ups. One touchup is included in your original payment. Optional color boost is an additional charge. Aftercare plays the number one role in color retention and long-lasting results. Each individual's skin heals and retains color differently. Results are not guaranteed.

Brows

- Keep brows moist at all times! (NO scabbing or peeling)
- Wipe clean with a damp paper towel or baby wipe before applying ointment to remove access oil, buildup, and lymph.
- Apply a thin layer of ointment as often as possible. At least every 2 to 3 hours and rub into the skin.
- You cannot over apply as long as you are rubbing it in well each time. Do not apply heavy globs without rubbing it in. Keep brows moist, flat, and smooth.
- Infrequent application of ointment will result in itching, flaking or scabbing.
- Stay out of the sun as much as possible. It can cause color loss.
- Avoid facial treatments near the brows for 30 days, especially chemical peels.
- Don't sweat, take a hot shower, or go in a sauna for the first 24 hours. Steam can cause color loss.
- Color goes through many changes. It usually appears dark, then very light, and then normal. You may experience color loss of up to 50%.
- Your eyebrow procedure is not complete without a 6 week touch up.

Eyeliner

- Avoid sun, sauna, steam, or hot shower for the first 24 hours.
- Apply ointment provided to you 5x a day and rub in very well with a clean finger.
- Continue using ointment for the first 28 days. If itchy, apply extra.
- Up to 50% of color may be lost. Color may disappear then resurface.
- Procedure is not complete without a six-week touch up.

Lips

- Lips may be swollen the first 3 days. Ice may reduce swelling if needed.
- Brush teeth as normal. May trigger cold sores if history of cold sores.
- Must keep moisturized at all times. Use aftercare provided to you as often as possible.
- Lips will appear very dark, then peel, then disappear, then resurface. Don't panic.
- Touchup required for desired color, saturation, and retention.
- Darker lips require additional treatments.
