- All contestants will receive an American Legion Auxiliary (ALA) Unit 1038 certificate of participation.
- ALA Unit 1038 will award a 1st place prize (\$50 gift card) to each class for the most compelling essay.
- Winners will then compete in the Westchester County American Legion Auxiliary competition if there are entries from other schools submitted in the same class. If there are no submissions from other Westchester County schools, the poster will automatically be entered into the American Legion Auxiliary Department of New York competition.
- The state winners compete in the national competition. National winners receive a citation, \$50 and a \$50 donation in the student's name is made to the *Spirit of Youth Scholarship Fund*.
