

#### CAN THESE DRY BONES LIVE AGAIN?

Again he said unto me, Prophesy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD. Ezekiel 37:4

As I read in the Book of Ezekiel, I felt a sense of restoration is needed. Many of us are at dry places in our lives and there is a need for us to begin to speak to these dry bones. Can you speak to your situation? Can these dry bones live again?

There are some broken relationships that exist in our lives. There are some old things that need to be revived in our lives. Though it is needed, many of us don't know how to go about doing it. Is this you? Do you need restoration in some areas in your life? Can these dry bones live again?

I often wonder what God thinks of the way that we handle situations in our lives. Should we walk away the way that we do? Or does He want us to handle the situations differently? Ezekiel's was the same as many of us at the beginning of his vision. When God asked him if the bones could live again rather than Him "saying yes", his reply was "God you know." How often does this happen to us? How many times does God ask us do we have the faith to, and our reply is God you know rather than God yes? How many times does God ask us can we speak life to our situations and our reply is God you know rather than yes?

I want to begin to encourage each person who has dry places in your life to begin to prophesy to it. Speak life where there appears to be death. If it is your marriage, then speak life. If it is your finances, then speak life. If it is your job, then speak life. If it is your holding pattern in life, then prophesy. If it is your dreams, then speak life. If it is old relationships, then speak life. You see when God asked Ezekiel if the bones could live his reply should have been "yes Lord." This is the same with us, when God is asking us if the dry bones can live again, we must believe in our hearts and answer with a "yes Lord."

So today know that those dry bones can live again. Those places that need restoration need you to speak life to them. God is not a God of hopelessness. If it is God's will then know that God can make a way. It takes your faith to believe that which you ask will be given unto you. Pray with expectancy. Pray with the knowledge that your prayers do not fall on deaf ears. God hears. God cares. God wants you to have the faith to believe that these dry bones can live again. And therefore remember "Again he said unto me, Prophesy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD. "

If you seek him, he will be found by you; but if you forsake him, he will reject you forever. 10 Consider now, for the LORD has chosen you to build a house as the sanctuary. Be strong and do the work."

The highs and lows of ministry are both experiences where I get pleasure when I look back over the 20 years. The lows proved that God was there beneath me to strengthen and guide me when I was facing depressing situations and circumstances. The highs remind me that God cares so much about me that He can entrust me with responsibilities, secrets, and plans that He hasn't entrusted to anyone else. It would be impossible to name them all.

#### The Lows:

- ▶ In the early 90's after a church wide agreement to move into DC, and a 6-month evangelistic training, when the church moved in DC only half the church (people) moved.
- ▶ In 1998 the community where the church was located was torn down by the DC Government, so Greater Grace Family Ministries moved again but could only find location in Maryland. Only 5 members relocated to the new church to start over.
