

2019 – 2024 Legislation Stava voted “Yes” to:

Most harmful bills to freedom and your pocketbook.

HB 370 **Repealed parental notification of abortion.** Consent no longer needed for minor to have abortion. 2019 Reproductive Health Care Act affirmed ‘fundamental right’ to make own decisions re: reproductive health care w/o govt interference. Called other state bans “attacks”

SB 25 Reproductive Health Care Act (2019) **massively expanded the right to an abortion in Illinois, making it a “fundamental right.”** Illinois Right to Life Action – 1st trimester to abortion on demand without apology throughout all 9 months of pregnancy. *Many people have no idea how radical our abortion law has become. Incredibly dangerous chemical abortion is only safe for a limited time during pregnancy. Planned Parenthood make abortion pill available for state residents. Annually, 20,000 to 30,000 women from other states come to Illinois for abortion care. It raises tens of millions \$.*

HB 3653 **Safe- T Act** This 2021 bill is first in the nation to **end all cash bail.** Makes changes to who can be detained and restricts judges’ decision making, Illinois criminates get to roam free, monitor free. Police officers hands will be tied. Won’t be able to hold anyone in jail more than 90 days. JGlasgow Will County States Attorney said, “will be the end of Illinois,” felons released.

HB 3447 **Fentanyl produced in China transported to U.S. by Mexican drug cartels.** No amount of fentanyl is safe, classifies possession of 3g as a misdemeanor, yet it would kill 1,500 people!

2022 Legislation Stava voted “Yes” to:

SB 2090 Requires Cook County to set up **polling places in county jails.**

SB 2408 Gives **massive subsidies to wind & solar projects,** shuts down coal plants by 2035 and natural gas plants by 2045. Incentivizes farmers to cover productive farmland with Chinese solar panels. Result: less reliable energy and higher costs for residents, businesses.

SB 1169 Right of Conscience Covid – Allowed any entity, person or business to impose any rule to prevent the spread of COVID. Categorized under **“healthcare rights”** take measures, impose requirements including involving **provision of services by a physician or healthcare provider.**

HB 156 **Menstrual hygiene products shall be in bathrooms of every school grades 4-12, including in boys bathrooms.** Access to affordable quality products is a “serious and ongoing need in IL.”

SB 818 Comprehensive Sex Ed, instead of learning ABCs, kindergarteners will learn about **gender + sexual orientation**. 6th graders masturbation. 8th graders anal sex. Sexual indoctrination, not education.

2023 Legislation Stava voted “Yes” to (or was not present “E”):

Most harmful bills to your freedom, and pocketbook in Illinois.

HB 3751 **Allows Non-Citizens to become Police Officers** authorized to carry a gun. Excused Absence

HB 2962 New **Employer requirements for Hiring Temporary Workers** during Strike 90 days or more.

SB 40 **Expands EV Charging Mandates on Housing** – req certain number of charging stations.

HB 1596 **Gender Neutral Language in State Statutes** – remove references to the gender binary. Provides **youth transitional housing to homeless minors 16-18 years** of age at taxpayer expense.

HB 3882 **Illegals Given Standard Driver License “that are nearly identical to . . .** , allow applicant to change his or her registered registration address as it appears on voter registration rolls.

HB 3326 **Forbids Using ALPR (Automated License Plate Readers) Information to Track Illegals** or Women Seeking Abortion from other States

SB 1909 **Forbids Free Speech of Pregnancy Centers**, prohibits pregnancy centers from advertising they offer pregnancy-related services and from inducing an individual to enter their center.

SB 1909 passe, was signed into law, and immediately litigated by Thomas More Society. The court imposed an immediate injunction and the judge said the bill is “stupid and likely unconstitutional.” AG Kwame Raoul subsequently said he would not enforce the law.*

HB 1286 **Requires gender neutral bathrooms** when public facilities rebuild or build new bathrooms. The bill specifies what gender neutral multi-stalled bathrooms are required to have.

****Legislative intent. The laws and public policy of this State have established the fundamental rights of individuals to make autonomous decisions about their own reproductive health (to kill babies), including the fundamental right to use or refuse reproductive health care. It is also the public policy of the State to ensure that patients receive timely access to information and medically appropriate care and consumers are protected from deceptive and unfair practices.***
