

2024 Legislation Anne Stava voted “Yes” to (or was not present “E”):

Most harmful bills to your freedom, and pocketbook in Illinois.

HB 2371 “Family Responsibility” Protected in Human Rights Act – defines family responsibilities to mean an employee’s actual or perceived provision of personal care to a family member.

HB 4582 Increases GO and Other Bonds Authorization Limit, increases debt limit by over \$5B, allows schools to build new bldgs. w/o referendum if done to house pre-school or kindergarten.

HB 4895 Mandated Climate Change Education, beginning 2025-26 school year every public school shall require a unit of instruction addressing climate change in science class or social studies class.

SB 2872 Relaxation Activity in Schools, provided for at least 20 minutes a week. Excused absence. An amendment made it permissive (not required as in original bill).

HB 587 Omnibus Energy Bill Expands Subsidies to Renewable Energy. Boosts development of renewable energy and infrastructure, eases regulation of new transmission lines to aid in getting solar and wind power to the grid. Incentivizes the building of grid-scale battery storage. Protects renewable energy firms from pricing spikes if renewable credits do not provide sufficient funding.E

HB 5164 Name Change Law for Illegals and Others – and individual who is not a citizen but is legally authorized to work in United States under federal law is authorized to apply for to be police officer. Petitioner may include spouse, adult unmarried children, minors in custody if in best interest. . .
