

Anne Stava's voting record reveals she voted yes to this 2019 blitz of bills. Her choices did not reflect the values and priorities of most voters in IL District 81:

SB 690 6/01/2019 Expands Number of Casinos Permitted in Illinois (raises revenue, hurts people)

HB 1438 5/31/2019 Authorizes Sale and Use of Recreational Cannabis (raises revenue, destroys lives)

SB262 5/31/2019 Establishes State Budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 (\$8B recklessly overspent)

HB 3606 5/31/2019 "Privacy Rights" for Student Data Collection (gets K-12 kids to squawk on parents)

SB 687 5/31/2019 Establishes a Graduated Tax Structure (to allow for more tax hikes, grow IL govt)

HB 834 5/29/2019 Requires Equal Pay (prohibits employers from asking re: applicant salary history)

SB 25 5/28/2019 Establishes "Protections" Regarding Abortion (permits killing for up to 9 months)

HB 1637 5/27/2019 Establishes Keep Illinois Families Together Act (restricts immigration enforcement)

SJRCA-1 5/27/2019 Repeals Non-Graduated Income Tax Rate Requirement (takes away citizen rights)

SB 1610 5/23/2019 Amends Immigrant Deportation Regulations (so alien defendant can change plea)

HB 2 4/11/2019 Establishes Rights for Women in Pregnancy and Childbirth (expands entitlements)

HB 2691 4/11/2019 Tuition Assistance to Transgender and Undocumented Immigrant Students (ugh!)

HB 3534 4/10/2019 Establishes a Non-Binary Gender Option on IDs (prevents truth re: biological sex)

HB 3394 3/29/2019 Requires Women, African Americans on Corporate Boards (violates civil rights)

HB 246 03/13/2019 Requires Public Schools to Teach about Prominent LGBTQ Figures (what????)

In 2019, Anne Stava voted with progressive caucus and Madigan 97.6% of the time. Laura Hois (R – Downers Grove), would have voted **NO to **ALL** of these bills which, unfortunately, became law in Illinois. It has only gotten worse since then!**
