Children's Discipleship Director

Principal Function: The Children's Discipleship Director is responsible for overseeing the various areas of children's ministry. This will involve coordinating, directing, and promoting a ministry to children, preschoolers, and their parents. The Children's Discipleship Director reports directly to the Associate Pastor of Family Discipleship

Responsibilities:

- Coordinate the complete program for children, birth through sixth grade. Oversee the Sunday and Wednesday evening programs for children, birth - 6th grade.
- 2. Lead in the enlistment of directors and teachers for children's and preschool programs in the church's total education program.
- 3. Recruit and train volunteers to fill the various ministry needs within the children's ministry.
- 4. Implement an on-going strategy for teacher and volunteer training. This includes things such as study courses, quarterly teachers' meeting, conferences, conventions, etc..
- 5. Work with appropriate personnel and committees to see that rooms, equipment, and supplies are kept in good order and replaced as needed.
- 6. Keep the church informed about Children's ministry activities and events through our various media outlets, (website, text, email, social media, etc...).
- 7. Oversee the development and implementation of policies that need to be incorporated into the children's ministry.
- 8. Prepare an annual budget for areas pertaining to children and preschoolers and provide constant fiscal management of those monies.
- 9. Coordinate the planning, promotion, and supervision of special events for children (i.e. kids camp, retreats, VBS, etc.).
- 10. Supervise the selection of all materials, curriculum, music, and resources to effectively communicate God's eternal truths; remain up-to-date on all new resources.
- 11. Purchase and oversee the use and maintenance of all equipment used by the Preschool and Children's Ministries.
- 12. Be available for counseling with workers, parents, and children.
- 13. Coordinate the use of church facilities for children's and preschool programs.
- 14. Perform all other responsibilities as assigned by the Pastor or Associate Pastor.
