

## The Transformative Paradigm & Lineage

Transformation is an incremental progression and is both personal, vital and differs in certain aspects from one to another. No two pathways are exactly the same, but the following is a very good paradigm for beginners and beyond.

Transforming from a human character to a conscious, spiritual being and eventually the "Divine Anthropos" (the archetype of perfected, divine-human wholeness) requires a comprehensive, and often lifelong process of inner purification, energetic shift, and surrender of the ego. This transformation entails a shift from selfish, mortal, and ego-driven consciousness to a state of being in alignment with the Divine, often described as a union of human and divine nature.

Actionable steps :

### 1. Fervent Inner Purification (Purgation)

- Adopting the "Divine Perspective": Consistently viewing life events, people, and oneself through the lens of divine love, unity, and truth rather than judgment.

### 4. Reaching the "Divine Anthropos" Status:

- Integration of Opposites: Actively integrating one's light and shadow, and uniting with the "self" (the divine image within), which marks the emergence of the Anthropos.
