Code of Conduct

All participants will treat other drivers, marshals, & spectators with RESPECT.

We promote a family atmosphere of fun. Please refrain from loud profanity or inappropriate discussions. If a person beside you can hear it, it is too loud.

The driver is responsible for his/her car. If you crash, it is your fault, not the marshal's, do not verbally abuse the marshals, they are there to help.

Politely discuss any disagreements with other drivers after you have finished your race and marshaled. Track officials will gladly arbitrate for any disagreements. Any verbal altercation deemed excessive will result in a 15-day race suspension.

Refrain from physical confrontations. Both/all drivers involved will be barred from participating in races for the remainder of the race season. Issue will be reviewed at the end of the race season. There will be no physical violence on the track property.

Parents will marshal for all novice drivers under the age of 8 yrs.

All Turn Marshals are to wear closed toe shoes. Failure to comply will result in you being disqualified from the main events. This is for your own safety.

Everyone needs to turn marshal, if you cannot turn marshal, you need a replacement. If you cannot find a replacement, we will find one for you.

Be aware of surroundings and possible dangers at the track such as snakes, scorpions, bees, uneven terrain etc.

Remove your trash or place trash in trash containers.

This is a gated and locked facility. First one in opens the gate and the last one out is responsible for closing and locking the gate. **Please do not share your gate code with non-members.**

IN ANY ACTION THAT RESULTS IN A SUSPENSION FROM RACING. THE RACER WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND ASKED TO LEAVE THE PREMISIES IMMEDIATELY, FORFIET THE ENTRY FEE AND POINTS IF DEEMED NECESSARY. YOUR ELEGIBILITY TO RACE WILL BE REVIEWED BY A TRACK COMMITTEE, AND AN OFFICIAL DESCISION WILL BE MADE WITHIN 5 BUSINESS DAYS.
