Construction Industry Overview

- Construction firms added 16,000 jobs in August, according to an analysis of federal employment data released by the Associated General Contractors of America. Association officials said their newly released <u>survey</u>, conducted with Autodesk, showed contractors are eager to hire more employees but are being stymied by a lack of qualified workers.
- Total construction employment climbed to 7,708,000 in August as both residential and nonresidential construction firms added jobs for the month.
- Nonresidential firms added 4,300 employees, as gains of 700 jobs at general building contractors and 5,600 at nonresidential specialty trade contractors offset a loss of 2,000 at heavy and civil engineering construction firms.
- Employment in residential construction-homebuilders, multifamily general contractors, and residential specialty trade contractors-increased by 10,900 in August.
- Compared to August 2021, the construction industry has added 311,000 jobs, an increase of 4.2 percent.
- One of the main causes of workforce shortages is the fact few people are being exposed to the opportunities available in the industry and lack basic, essential skills. 77% percent of contractors report there are few workers available that meet the minimum qualification standards, including being able to pass a drug test, which is something insurance companies require for all workers in the industry.
- 56% percent of firms use cloud-based technology for project management. 47% of contractors use the technology for field operations. 45% use it for accounting.
 41% use it for time tracking

Construction Industry Customer Pain Points

- 74% of administrators manually enter data on physical time clocks, spreadsheets or paper timesheets, which result in weekly errors that can cost time and money ¹
- Logistics can be difficult for contractors with seasonal and mobile employees working in different locations throughout the day
- Illegible or lost time cards are common
- Manual process can take hours with scheduling and entering employee hours
- Overtime can accumulate causing increased payroll costs without "real time" time tracking and monitoring of team
- Capturing/Tracking Billable Hours. Billing clients can be tricky
 and time consuming without proper time tracking procedures

 job codes or custom fields.
- Scheduling. Missed shifts or miscommunication with scheduling can cause time or money. Need an easy way to create or edit schedules and push notifications to employees of any changes.
- Buddy Punching can occur causing time theft.

QuickBooks Time does NOT clock employees out after 24 hours like other time tracking systems. Employees or Supervisors manage time by either clocking themselves and/or their crews in and outs or allocating time by entering summary hours at the end of the day. An employee will only be clocked out of QuickBooks Time after 7 full days on the clock. This means the QuickBooks Time's timer can run up to 168 hours.
