The successful applicant will work in the Diocesan Office in Corner Brook and will report directly to the Bishop. This is a full-time position (35 hours per week) and the incumbent will be expected to work a flexible schedule when necessary. A valid driver's licence and use of a private vehicle is an ongoing condition of employment. Some travel throughout the Diocese is required.

We are welcoming new members to our parish bereavement teams and invite you to join us. You will be provided with proper training and sufficient time to adjust to your new role.
