Applications are invited for the **position of Diocesan Director of Evangelization and Catechesis**. We are seeking an individual with excellent organizational and leadership skills who can work independently. The successful applicant will work in the Diocesan Office in Corner Brook and will report directly to the Bishop. This is a full-time position (35 hours per week) and the incumbent will be expected to work a flexible schedule when necessary. A valid driver's licence and use of a private vehicle is an ongoing condition of employment. Some travel throughout the Diocese is required.

BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY:

We are a group of people who compassionately perform various tasks related to funerals in our parish. The bereavement team and the presiding priest meet with the grieving family to plan a mass of Christian burial or a funeral home liturgy. The team supports the family by listening, lifting them up with prayer and encouragement. They coordinate the required set up for the funeral service and notify all involved such as musicians, readers, servers, gift bearers etc. They conduct a practice to ensure the family is comfortable with their role in the service. The team attends and assists at the funeral home vigil and the mass of Christian burial. After the funeral a member of the bereavement team would call or visit the family while maintaining boundaries and privacy of the grieving family. We are welcoming new members to our parish bereavement teams and invite you to join us. You will be provided with proper training and sufficient time to adjust to your new role.
