SOLEMNITY OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF

<u>CHRIST</u>: This Sunday is the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, which celebrates our belief that, during Mass, the Holy Spirit acts upon the bread and wine so that they become the Body and Blood of Christ.

The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (which is also known as Corpus Christi) helps us to refocus on three things that we are called to do at every Mass – to celebrate our belief in the risen Christ, to witness to our faith in Christ by how we live our lives and to become Christ by receiving His Body and Blood. Having received the Body and Blood of Christ, we become His presence to the world.

PRAYER BEFORE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT:


