

## The Curse NM Code of Conduct

1. Curse members and Curse affiliate group members support, protect and uplift the Curse, New Mexico United and all fans. This includes, but is not limited to, being respectful of and courteous to fellow Curse members; New Mexico United players, technical staff and front office; matchday officials and support staff; and other New Mexico United patrons both inside and outside the stadium, as well as online.
2. You are expected to adhere to the Curse Code of Conduct (this document), the [New Mexico United Fans Code of Conduct](#), the [USL Fan Code of Conduct](#), as well as the stadium/venue's Code of Conduct (if applicable), whether at home or away matches, at Curse events, or when utilizing the services of a Curse business partner. 3. Defacing or destruction of property, whether at a home or away venue, will not be tolerated. Violations will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including permanent removal from the Curse.
4. We embrace all persons willing to abide by the Curse Code of Conduct and support New Mexico United no matter their race, national origin, religion, political views, sexual orientation, gender identity, physical ability or supporters group affiliation. Discrimination or prejudice of any kind will never be tolerated and will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including permanent removal from the Curse.
5. Members shall not slander, misrepresent or spread misinformation about fellow New Mexico United supporters groups and/or other team's supporters groups. We promote unity and respect and always welcome others wishing to join us to support New Mexico United.
6. Online harassment of fellow supporters, players, game officials, front office or technical staff is strictly prohibited. Harassment is defined as a single act or course of conduct directed toward an individual or group of people that serves no legitimate purpose other than to annoy, intimidate, frighten, alarm, torment, or abuse that person or group. Violation may be subject to disciplinary action up to and including permanent removal from the Curse.
7. Members must respect the privacy of fellow Curse members and all persons employed by New Mexico United including, but not limited to, players, technical staff and front office.

8. Violence of any kind, including verbal or physical threats is strictly prohibited and will result in disciplinary action up to and including permanent removal from the Curse.
9. Throwing of objects on the field, or in the direction of other fans, supporters, or match officials poses a danger to all in attendance and will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Violation may result in disciplinary action up to and including permanent removal from the Curse.
10. Responsible consumption of alcoholic beverages is acceptable. However, overly intoxicated members who visibly lack the ability to control themselves will be prohibited from participating in certain activities and events for the safety of themselves and other supporters. Excessive instances may result in temporary or permanent ban from the Curse. As dictated by law, alcohol purchase, possession or consumption by a minor is illegal and will not be tolerated.
11. Inappropriate touching, unwanted advances, or sexual harassment is never tolerated by the Curse. Any violation of this rule should be reported to the nearest event staff safety personnel or law-enforcement official.
12. Any discriminatory, racist or homophobic speech and/or chants (including the goal kick or “p-word” chant) will not be tolerated. In accordance with the New Mexico United Fan Code of Conduct and the USL Fan Code of Conduct, guests in violation of this rule can be removed from the stadium and will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including permanent removal from the Curse. Use of any Curse logos, trademarks or intellectual property is subject to the approval of Curse executive leadership.
13. As a member of the Curse, you will, at times, have access to confidential information pertaining to the Curse or New Mexico United. Any information shared outside of the Curse will be in violation of our Code of Conduct and may result in disciplinary action up to and including removal from the Curse.
14. Violations of the Curse Code of Conduct may result in temporary or permanent ban from the Curse. The Curse reserves the right to modify or extend this Code of Conduct at any time. Curse members will receive 7-day notice of any changes before going into effect via email at the Curse member’s registered email address.
