Position Overview

JP Tank is seeking a skilled **Concrete Pump Operator / CDL Driver / Shop Logistics Coordinator** to support field operations and logistics.

The primary responsibility of this position is operating our **Schwing 46-meter concrete pump truck** during concrete placements.

When not operating the pump, this position supports company operations by:

- transporting equipment and materials to job sites using a semi-truck and trailer
- managing shop yard logistics and equipment organization

This role is ideal for someone who is **mechanically inclined, dependable, and experienced operating heavy equipment.**

Primary Responsibilities

Concrete Pump Truck Operation

Operate and manage the company's **Schwing 46-meter concrete pump truck** during concrete placements.

Responsibilities include:

Setting up and stabilizing the pump truck

Coordinating with foremen and crews during pours

Monitoring the concrete pump for mechanical issues prior to, during, and after pumping

Monitoring safe operation of the boom during pumping

Communicating with concrete truck drivers and excavation crew

Pump Setup, Cleanup & Maintenance

Perform full pump preparation and shutdown procedures including:

Pump setup and teardown

Hose management

Washout and cleanup after pours

Greasing and lubrication of pump components

Performing basic pump inspections

Performing minor to mid-range pump maintenance

Reporting any mechanical issues

Concrete pumping typically occurs **4-5 times per week during peak construction season.**

CDL Driving & Jobsite Logistics

When not pumping concrete, this position supports field operations by transporting equipment and materials to job sites.

Typical loads may include:

Concrete forms

Rebar

Job trailers

Shipping containers

Telehandlers

Skid loaders

Mini excavators

Other jobsite materials and equipment

This role requires operating a **semi truck and trailer**, including occasional oversized (wide) loads.

Shop Yard Operations

When not on job sites, this role helps manage the company's shop yard in Rosendale.

Responsibilities include:

Loading and unloading equipment and materials from trailers

Organizing jobsite materials returned from projects

Putting tools and equipment away in proper storage locations

Maintaining organized equipment storage areas

Assisting with trailer organization

General shop cleaning and yard maintenance

Ensuring the shop remains organized and ready for upcoming projects.

Equipment Maintenance

Perform basic equipment maintenance including:

Greasing equipment

Checking fluid levels

Inspecting equipment condition

Coordinating repairs when needed

Helping maintain trailers and small equipment

Strong mechanical aptitude is highly valued in this role.

Travel & Work Schedule

Most pump work occurs on **local projects in Wisconsin**, but some travel may be required depending on project location.

Local Work

Most concrete pours occur within driving distance of the shop.

Occasional Travel

Some projects may require limited travel with crews to out-of-town job sites.

Company vehicles are used for transportation.

Work Schedule

Typical schedule:

Approximately **40-50 hours per week**

Concrete pours may require **early morning start times**

Non-pour days typically begin around **7:00 AM**

Schedule generally runs **Monday through Friday**, with occasional overtime depending on project needs.
