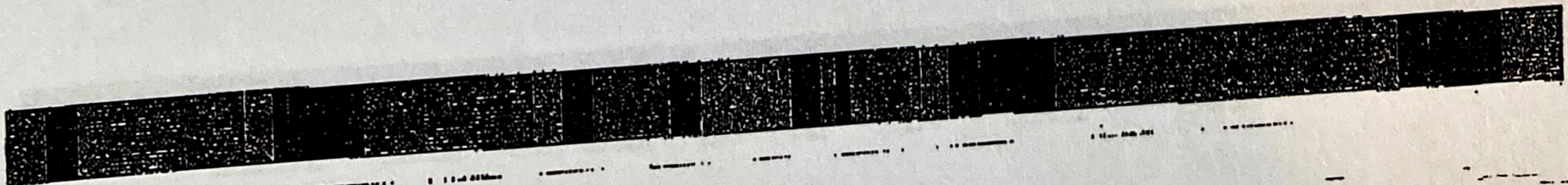

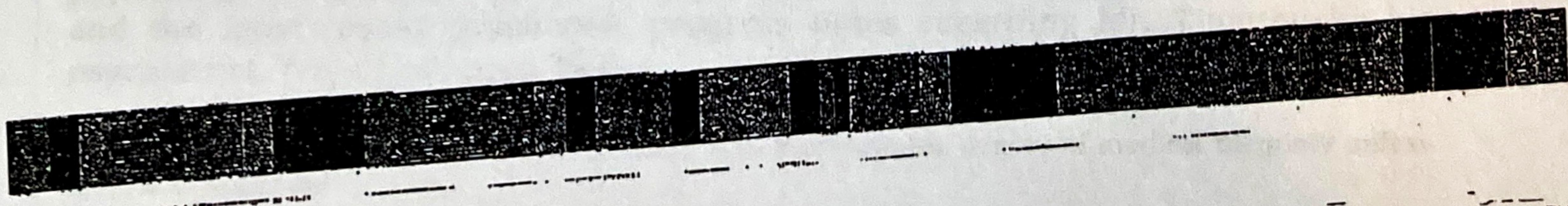

Dear Ms. McConkie:

Thank you for having referred Mr. Timothy to me for evaluation. In particular, you have asked that I address eight specific questions regarding Mr. Timothy (hereinafter "Eric"), especially with respect to his relationship to his step-father, Gordon Bowen. This letter is a succinct summary of my opinions* regarding those questions, and these opinions are enumerated in the same order in which you presented the eight questions to me in your letter of January 20, 2009.

Please note that this report is intended as a summary only of my opinions and will not restate the extensive facts, as this has already been done in considerable detail by others before me. I will be glad, though, if you would like, to provide you with a more detailed report upon your written request to do so. Also, I reserve the right to modify any of my opinions in the event that additional evidence should come to my attention that would warrant such modification.

Sources of Information

Over the course of the last several months, I interviewed Eric on five occasions, totaling approximately 8.5 hours. I also interviewed his mother, Barbara Timothy Bowen, his brother, Colin Timothy, Dr. Trent Holmberg and Dr. Juan Mejia for collateral data.

In addition, I carefully reviewed several hundred pages of documents, including the psychological evaluation of Mr. Timothy by Juan Mejia, Ph.D (from May 11, 2009) and the most recent psychiatric progress notes regarding Mr. Timothy by his psychiatrist, Trent Holmberg, M.D..

*All opinions expressed herein are expressed with a reasonable degree of medical certainty unless otherwise indicated.

Forensic Advisements

I advised Mr. Timothy that I was working as a forensic consultant to you and I was not

seeing him in a doctor-patient treatment relationship. I also explained that he did not have to answer questions if he chose not to do so.

Furthermore, I explained that my work with him would not enjoy the typical privacy afforded to doctor-patient relations and that I would be sharing my impressions and opinions with you. I also noted that you could ask me to document my opinions and to appear in court to testify, and that I would need to tell the truth regardless of whether that would help or hurt his case.

He agreed to proceed without any questions or hesitations.

Question #1: Yes: Eric has suffered from "grooming behaviors perpetrated upon him by Gordon Bowen." Eric trusted Mr. Bowen in a number of ways and he has been traumatized by the way in which Mr. Bowen violated his trust. Mr. Timothy feels violated, betrayed and used for purposes unrelated to his (Mr. Timothy's) best developmental interests.

Question #2: I cannot tell with reasonable medical certainty whether Eric has suffered from "disparaging or demeaning remarks about his mother Barbara Owen."

Question #3): Yes, from Eric's report (as well described in Dr. Mejia's report of May 11, 2009), when Eric was about 16 years old, Mr. Bowen touched Eric's hand and penis while Eric was masturbating. As Dr. Mejia noted, "he joined Eric in the masturbation act."

Mr. Bowen reportedly would require Eric to sleep in the same hotel bed with him on trips where Eric would accompany Mr. Bowen. This type of circumstance occurred with some frequency. By itself, a step-father sleeping with his pubescent step-son - particularly when not genuinely necessary - raises serious clinical issues: viz. the son's mental health; and the step-father's potential motives, intentions and explanations (none of which can be properly assessed without appropriate evaluation of the step-father).

For the step-father to touch his step-son during masturbation is a profound sexual violation that would be likely to have serious psychosexual repercussions, and it did, indeed, have such an adverse effect on Eric. That effect has been of a posttraumatic stress disorder nature, as well illustrated by the intense dysphoria, anxiety and emotional distress displayed by Eric when he was talking with me about that event.

does Eric) to also suffer from co-morbid drug abuse. It is well known that co-morbid disorders such as depression and PTSD are risk factors for the development and/or aggravation of drug abuse: i.e., those disorders increase the risk that the patient will consequently suffer from drug abuse.

Since Eric's depression and PTSD are related to his relationship with Mr. Bowen, then it is equally true that his drug abuse is also related to his relationship with Mr. Bowen.

But, I think it would be over-reaching to opine that Eric suffers from drug abuse only because of his relationship with Mr. Bowen. For example, Eric also suffers from Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), and that, too, is often associated with an increased risk of drug abuse.

Question #8): Yes, Eric suffers "from increased anger as a result of [his relationship with] Gordon Bowen." His anger is borne out of the following.

Eric feels betrayed and taken advantage of by Mr. Bowen. He lost his father and grieved his death at a young age. He was grieving and looking for a father figure to comfort, console and guide him. Naturally, he looked to his mother's new husband, Mr. Bowen, for that.

At the time, he was not only young and at a fragile developmental point in his life, but his grief made him all the more vulnerable to the undue psychosexual influences to which he was subjected by Mr. Bowen.

Moreover, Eric has witnessed and experienced considerable disruption to his nuclear family as a result of the turmoil attending his mother's separation from Mr. Bowen and their divorce proceedings.

Finally, since Eric is highly sensitized to the traumatic experiences he has suffered as a result of his own relationship with Mr. Bowen, he is acutely fearful for his younger brother's and sister's psychosexual well-being. He worries often that, when they are with Mr. Bowen, they will be taken advantage of, molested or groomed, as he himself feels he was.

His concerns have considerable merit; they are not simply the result of a self-serving or misguided agenda. The record is far too full of credible evidence for that.

Eric is angry for all of the above reasons and also because he believes that "the system" is ignoring his brother's and sister's right to be safe with their father. He

Question #4): Yes: the memory of Mr. Bowen touching Eric's hand and penis while he (Eric) was masturbating was a repressed memory (i.e., a memory he has heretofore been unable to recall).

Question #5): I am unable to answer this question with a reasonable degree of medical certainty.

Question #6): Eric has suffered unmistakable "sexual problems" as a result of Mr. Bowen's influence on and behavior toward him during an important psychosexual developmental phase of his life. Eric is confused about the nature of Mr. Bowen's behavior towards him, as he had believed that Mr. Bowen loved him, cared for him and had his best interests in mind.

Mr. Bowen acted in a way that Eric would naturally interpret as sexually suggestive, provocative and inviting. That interpretation, however, is at loggerheads with the conflicting concept of genuine paternal love for a step-son.

On the one hand, adolescent Eric was most likely both intrigued and repulsed by Mr. Bowen's sexually suggestive conduct*. Latent homosexual fantasies and drives are not uncommon in children and teens, and the kind of behavior that Eric has described by Mr. Bowen would probably be highly stimulating (in both positive and negative terms, generating powerful conflicting feelings and urges, and thus, intensely painful anxiety and distress).

In my opinion, Eric's psychosexual development (i.e., the psychological array of feelings, values, drives, etc accompanying Eric's nascent sexual orientation) was stymied and adversely impacted by his relationship with Mr. Bowen.

On the other hand, I cannot opine with reasonable medical certainty whether Eric is "unable to form heterosexual relationships because of Gordon Bowen," as you queried of me.

Question #7): It is highly probable that the emotional struggles Eric has suffered as a result of his relationship with Mr. Bowen have contributed to his struggles with drugs. It is not uncommon for patients suffering from depression and PTSD (as


*Notably, I cannot opine with reasonable medical certainty whether Mr. Bowen deliberately or intentionally tried to groom and/or proposition Eric, as such an opinion would first necessitate a proper evaluation of Mr. Bowen. Since I have not evaluated Mr. Bowen, I cannot opine as to his motives or intentions, regardless of how destructive his behaviors have been towards Eric. This is a critical point, however, to more clearly understand: not just for Eric's sake, but also for his younger brother's and sister's sake, as Mr. Bowen has joint custodial privileges of those children.

Although I have yet to speak to one of the attorneys in this case, the more feedback I get about the serious possible negative consequences of including Lily and Caleb, the more concerned I become.

Is it not possible to include them in another way--using the publicity generated from Collin and Eric to tell their story or using Collin and Eric's history with Gordon to take more measures to protect the children from Gordon?

Kathleen, did you speak to Alan concerning this? When do I get to talk with the attorneys? I have tried to stay as far away from this as I can, but obviously, I am now in a position that I need to get involved or remove myself completely.

Also, please remember that I am planning a trip to New England August 3-15.

(We may still need to go to court so he doesn't try to take the children the week before school starts- Aug 17 (18) -23 as he has indicated.)
