

maintain his own deception about his homosexuality and sexual conflicts. He either cherishes the fantasy about Barbara, "the dream wife," exalting her far above any realistic person she could ever become, or sees Barbara as the devil incarnate who must be destroyed.

Dr. Harrison suggests that Gordon manifests strong symptoms of 1. Narcissistic Personality Disorder, 2. Dissociative Amnesia, 3. Depersonalization disorder,

5. Depression, 5. Anxiety, 6. Dissociative Identity Disorder. Gordon's switching of personalities and the amnesic barriers between them results in a very chaotic life. Because his personalities often interact with each other, Gordon's probable Dissociative Identity Disorder creates Gordon's report of hearing inner conversations and the voices of other personalities, which often comment on or address his family conflicts. These voices can be experienced as hallucinations. In Gordon's journals, he often becomes the voice of God, and this voice tells him to destroy Barbara and take no captives.

Thom says privately to me that in 30 years of practice he has never dealt with such a disturbing profile except when he worked with Ted Bundy in the prison. He tells me that he wanted to use a stronger diagnosis, e.g. anti-social personality disorder, but hesitated to do so in a limited evaluation.

During a therapy session in which I brought my father, Alma H. Boyce, my father asked Dr. Harrison if he thought I was in danger. Dr. Harrison said, "Mr. Boyce, I would not be truthful to you if I didn't tell you that your daughter is in potential danger. I believe, personally, that if Gordon Bowen is literally capable of murder if he has not already murdered."

68. November 2004. Gordon begins proceedings for temporary orders. Court date set for December 8. After we file his journal, enemy list and Thom Harrison's evaluation, they extend until March 31, 2005. Gordon is seeking visitation with the children every weekend.
69. Discovery finished, except Gordon's answers to admissions and interrogatories which he refused to answer because he said they were not relevant. These are questions about his homosexual behavior. The financial discovery Gordon presents is the box of financial documents that he stole from me in January 2003 which I had prepared.
70. January 2005 Eric is picked up for drinking while driving. Loses his license again.
71. February 2005. Eric is picked up for driving on a suspended license. Loses his license for two years.
72. March 2005. I get Eric to go to Anasazi Wilderness Survival in lieu of his plea abeyance program. I have asked Gordon for over a year to sell the BMW he gave Eric and put it into an educational/rehabilitation fund for Eric. Gordon refuses to do this or anything else to help Eric. Gordon ignores e-mails saying that Eric has had suicidal ideation and telephone conversations in which I tell about Eric's need for help. During this 2 ½ year period of serious psychological, emotional, and legal problems with Eric, Gordon's only help is to sneak Eric away from home with this friend and send them to Disneyland with the promise that he will make them Disney models. This violates Eric's plea abeyance program.
73. March 31, 2005. Gordon is given supervised, standard visitation with 30 days prior notice. Renaissance is the supervision agency. Gordon and I are both to have psychological testing. We have submitted three names based on Thom Harrison's evaluation—Dr. Susan Mirrow as the forensic psychiatric evaluator, Dr. Carlos Roby as the psychosexual evaluator, and Dr. Lawrence Beal as the psychological evaluator. Gordon refuses them, recommends Heather Walker. The court suggests that we each submit three names as possible evaluators. My attorney, Lisa Reading convinces me that we should use Heather Walker who is her friend and whom Lisa feels is a good evaluator. I am suspect of anyone Gordon wants to use in this capacity but I feel I need to trust my attorney.
74. I seek help for Lily, beginning with Johanna McManimin, Thom Harrison's recommendation. Dr. McManimin tells me that she will not help me if I'm in litigation. She suggests others whom I call: Cinda Morgan, Lindy Burton, Jan Ellen Burton, John Merriweather, Jeffery Grant and Nancy Hansen. All of them tell me that they do not want to do the therapy if I'm in litigation.
75. June 2005. Visitation begins with Renaissance as supervisors. Merry Trujillo is assigned to the case and, with few exceptions, her daughter, Curly Hunsaker is assigned as the supervisor despite my attorney's request for other supervisors for a more objective opinion. Gordon takes Curly to Mitt Romney's cabin, the ballet, LaCaille for Curly's birthday. He buys expensive toys for the children, a lot of candy, movies, entertainment at every visit. Caleb is rarely allowed a nap. The children come home exhausted, yet hyper from sugar. I write a letter to Renaissance with my concerns about the toys, sugar, lack of naps, etc. I point out that my real concern about the constant sugar is that in Gordon's journal God tells him that eating sugar is a way for evil spirits to inhabit one's body. I receive no response. Merry tells me that she is making "exceptions" for our case.
76. I learn later that just prior to Gordon beginning with Renaissance, they were having terrible financial difficulties and could not make their payroll. After Gordon began being supervised by them, they not only easily made their payroll, but employees and clients commented that Merry was spending money wildly, buying new cars, bragging about having a \$15,000 plasma screen television, gambling at Wendover and passing out money. When one of the employees asked her why she made such exceptions for Gordon, e.g. taking the children from me before Gordon arrived and having the staff watch them for up to two hours at a time (which is entirely against their policy), Merry's reply was, "I make exceptions because Gordon pays the big bucks." Gordon's company did a billion dollars in billings that year.

77. Russ Hettinger is supposed to file a motion to compel to get answers for interrogatories and admission which Gordon has refused to answer. Russ fails to do this due to health problems.
78. July 31, 2005. Gordon, Collin, Eric and I meet with my bishop, Marcus Pinnock to discuss Eric's situation. It is decided that Gordon will quit trying to lure Collin and Eric to take a trip with him to Rome, quit trying to get Eric into his own apartment (Dr. Doug Gray tells me that Eric in his own apartment at that time would be a disaster). I have hired an educational psychologist out of San Francisco, Boden and Associates and present three programs which they have suggested that I want to visit with Eric. Gordon agrees to give me miles to visit the programs and offers to pay for the programs. I decline all but ask for miles to visit the first program in California because I want to go immediately at Dr. Gray's recommendation. (I have been planning a trip to England beginning August 8 to see my son's family and new grandbaby at Gordon's suggestion, but Gordon was so resistant to sign the passport form for Lily and Caleb that, although expedited, the passport for Lily has not arrived yet.) I arrange with Delta through Gordon's American Express account to get tickets. Scott at American Express talks with Gordon and he gives permission for the tickets.
79. While visiting the Alpha Academy, on August 12, 2005 I receive a call from Curly at Renaissance stating that Mr. Bowen is there for his regularly scheduled visit. Both Gordon and Renaissance know that this is my vacation time and that I have chosen to use it to help Eric. Gordon uses this in an affidavit before the court stating I took the children out of state without his permission and preempted his visitation. This is one of countless games I encounter with him in his design to make me look like an alienating parent.
80. In subsequent proceedings, Gordon tries to overturn the decision for no overnight visitation, but the commissioner denies it.
81. September 2005, Eric leaves for the Alpha Academy in San Luis Obispo. He is obligated for 6 months as an alternative to his plea and abeyance program in Salt Lake City.
82. October 7, 2005. I realize Gordon has not been on the schedule he proposed. My attorney writes him a letter apprising him that he needs to get back on schedule. He comes for a visit anyway. (We realize that he has never given Renaissance his proposed written schedule.) October 8. I feel bad that he had come and missed a visit, but Caleb is sick with a fever, so I call him to come to my home, offer for him to take the children any way but want him to see for himself that Caleb is sick. He declines the offer. I ask him to please work together in the best interest of the children. I tell him about Lily's Primary Program at church and ask if she can attend. He tells me that he has always said that Lily could go to her own Primary. He later states in an affidavit that I yelled at him and told him to go away and never see our family again. This is a complete lie and antithetical to the fact that I have invited him over and offered for him to take the children even though he doesn't have a scheduled visit.
83. October 2005. Psychological testing begins with Heather Walker. It is decided that it needs to be expanded to a more comprehensive parent-time evaluation. Gordon meets with Heather Walker first. When I meet with her, she tells me that I am not to talk about Gordon. She is very cold with me and even argumentative when I try to say anything about Gordon. I find out that my attorney, Lisa Reading, has sent the entire file (about 1500 pages) to Heather Walker concerning Gordon, all that I have accumulated and given to her. I am alarmed because it contains things that I would not want her to have and it is also two years old. I ask Lisa why she didn't consult with me first. She says she thought she did.
84. October 27, 2005. Gordon and I go to mediation. He wants Thanksgiving holiday even though it is my year. He wants no supervision and to have overnight visitation. He states again that Renaissance will do the overnight visitation if needed although they don't normally do this. He wants to take the children to Disneyland.
85. November 24, 2005. I invite Gordon to Thanksgiving dinner at my house even though it is my year. He comes and plays with the children. November 26, 2006. Curly calls me from Renaissance and tells me that Mr. Bowen is there for his visit. She says she called me on Wednesday, November 23 to remind me. I tell her there were no calls/messages on my cell or home phone. I call my attorney and she tells me that Gordon has not right to this weekend and he knows it but that he's trying to set me up again before the court to look like I'm keeping him from the children. Now I know that Curly lies for Gordon.
86. December 2005. We attend the hearing. Commissioner Bloomquist denies Gordon his requests until the psychological testing is completed.
87. December 2005. My sons, Collin and Eric meet with Heather Walker. Collin tells me that he tries to tell her that he feels Gordon is a sociopath. She becomes angry with him and tells him that Gordon is split but not a sociopath.
88. January 2005. Visitation continues with Renaissance. Curly, especially, treats me with disdain. We contact with her is limited as I drop off the children and pick them up. My only questions are whether the children has had naps and eaten. She usually refuses to answer and treats me with disgust and disregard.
89. April 2006. Psychological testing is resumed. It has taken months for the order to come through. Heather Walker tells me she doesn't know why. When I meet with Heather Walker this time, she is completely resistant to me, argumentative, even angry at anything I try to tell her. She has allowed Gordon to be observed at a friend's home, Louise and Spencer Hill, while he makes

a birthday cake for me with the children. Her first question to me is how I liked the cake. I explain that it is one more example of Gordon's public posturing, e.g. for years he told people how much he loved me while privately abusing me. She refuses to hear anything I have to say about Gordon, defends him and berates me. I return to be observed with my children. Dr. Walker insists that it be in her office. When I bring an art and reading project from a manual for children's self-worth which I have written, she refuses to let me use it and tells me that we have to use one of her games.

- 90. May 2006. I hire expert witness, Christopher Barden who is an attorney and a psychologist. I can tell that Heather Walker is against me by her attitude.
- 91. June 26. My mother dies.
- 92. June 27. Gordon begins his legal onslaught with requests for Lily and Caleb July 1-4. I ask him for some time July 3 or 4 for family gather prior to funeral on July 5. Gordon refused to come at all. Gives me this "gift."
- 93. June 29. I make plane reservations for a trip to Massachusetts with Lily and Caleb to see my son, Adam and his family.
- 94. July 5. Funeral for my mother
- 95. July 6. Gordon schedules a notice of hearing for Aug 9 for statutory parent time. His attorney says she is hell bent on keeping that date.
- 96. July 7. I fax Lisa Reading my intended vacation schedule. July 19-31, cabin rental, August 7- 19, Mass. Lisa does not forward it on to Gordon's attorney.
- 97. July 8. I receive a holiday visitation schedule demanding 39 days straight with Lily and Caleb and other extended holidays. I also fax it to Lisa Reading. She does not get a copy from his attorney.
- 98. July 12, I receive notice from my attorney that Gordon has scheduled a hearing for August 9, 2006. Apparently the psychological testing is completed. Attorneys are supposed to meet with psychologist, Heather Walker to get results. **Gordon is confident the results are in his favor.**

My attorney, Lisa Reading is leaving for Europe July 21-August 5. She is not able to get the results before she leaves. She files for an extension.

Lisa and Gordon's attorney will have a telephone conversation with Commissioner Blomquist Thursday, July 20 where Lisa will ask for an extension. Gordon's attorney, Kara Barton says she is hell bent to see that we do not get an extension. We need one so that Christopher Barden, expert witness can be there to testify

- 99. a. **Merry Trujillo pulls me aside on July 31 and says, "I know there's a lot of talk about us being bought off and Heather Walker being bought off, but we're just in the middle of this trying to do our jobs. I explain to her that Gordon had manipulated them by first not giving them a schedule and then giving them a schedule that he portrays as agreed upon by both parties but is not and shows up for visits he doesn't have and tries to make it look like I'm keeping him from the children.**

79. The testing shows incredible bias on the part of Dr. Walker towards Gordon. He is "pathology free," and I am shown as obsessed, paranoid and not credible. Merry Trujillo states that she fears I am so concerned about the extended visits that I may do harm to myself or the children. Heather Walker takes at face value everything Gordon has to say about me and puts it into print. .

- 80. Hearing is moved to August 14. That morning we are presented with notes from Renaissance stating that Caleb, my 3 year old son said to Gordon that "mommy says you are the son of Satan, ypu are evil, you are in Satan's power because you don't follow the commandments. Apparently Gordon got Curly to put this in her report and then print it so he could have it for that next morning for court. He went to his attorney's house that night and cried on her couch about how sad it was to have to deal with a wife like me who turns the children from him. The commissioner decides that Gordon will be give unsupervised day visits but supervised at night. And if we have nothing more to contest Gordon's request for an extended week visitation requesting the children go with him to New York for the Macy's parade, it will be given to him. We present our motion to compel for answers to admissions and production of documents. Russ points out the discrepancy that Gordon told us he made \$240,000 in 2002 whereas he made \$1,500,000 and owes the IRs \$710,000.

- 81. Gordon gives us his 2002 and 2003 taxes and answers to admissions. The answers don't say directly that he lied, but they say he was not forthcoming in the past.
- 82. I hire Dennis Williams, at the recommendation of Bob Alsop, to begin gathering more affidavits and later to go through the financial information.
- 83. Russ presents a motion asking for Gordon to pay for the discovery information he has failed to produce, plus pay for the expert witness.
- 84. Kara Barton is trying to get a court date early in October to depose Heather Walker so Gordon can take the children to New York.

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85. Lisa wants to try to set a date later in October, but to date (September 26, we have not received the test results and Dr. Barden requires 60 days to prepare)
Dr. Barden keeps asking Lisa for documentation of her attempts to serve Kara Barton and is refused.
84. Gordon continues to come for his visits, but begins canceling Friday visits again. He missed to many that Merry originally told him she was canceling all of them.
85. Lily tells me that Curly snores. Then she says that she knows that Gordon and Curly are in love, that Gordon doesn't kiss her, but he does put his arm around her. She says that they don't let her hear what they are saying, but she knows they love each other and are going to get married. Lily reports two Sunday afternoons when Curly and her three daughters show up at the Grand America hotel. On September 24, Lily says that Curly and her daughters were just leaving the hotel when Gordon, Lily and Caleb show up. She says that Curly likes the hotel. Gordon is still renting the two rooms he had for Saturday night's visit Sunday night. Why, unless Curly and her daughters are staying there?
86. September 2006. My attorney, Lisa Reading, drops out. She says that she can't work with Christopher Barden and that she feels I don't trust her because I keep asking her if she can ask the "hard questions" of Renaissance and Dr. Walker.
87. September 2006. I hire Steve Russell. We begin to get information about Renaissance. Apparently Merry Trujillo has lost her license as a drug and alcohol counselor in 2003 but still acts in that capacity. Merry has had two DUI's, one with a child at 6:45 a.m., spent time in jail and has had reports of domestic violence with her partner, business and personal partner, Carol Gage.
88. November 1, 2006. We set up a deposition date for Merry Trujillo, Carol Gage, Curly Hunsaker (Merry's daughter), and a staff member, Shawna Daniels. They all refuse to come and we learn that Merry has threatened Shawna that if she attends, Merry will fire her.
89. Shawna quits Renaissance and files a complaint with DOPL concerning Merry Trujillo's drug testing without a license. DOPL is presenting doing an investigation. In a private conversation with Shawna Daniels, she reports the corruption of Renaissance. She reports the domestic violence between Merry and Carol, even in while children are present at Renaissance. We learn that Merry referred Gordon to his lesbian attorney, Kara Barton, a close friend of Merry's. We learn that among her staff Merry refers to me as "crazy Barbara," "mentally ill Barbara," and that she tells them I am dangerous and she fears I will kill myself or the children. (I reflect on Gordon's statement from God in his journal that says I will kill the children and be sent to prison.) We learn that Merry Trujillo and Carol Gage have a close association with Heather Walker who has relied heavily on them for her evaluation. (Heather Walker recommends that Lily be seen by Carol Gage for therapy.)
90. After the last two visits, November 4,5, November 22-26, I am more and more concerned about the condition of the children when they return. They come back exhausted, unkempt and exhibit strange behavior after. On November 6, Lily refused to go to school. She was crying and clingy. I consulted with the school psychologist and finally got Lily to stay for the afternoon. Upon return from another visit, Lily manifested strange behavior by getting out of the bath tub and hiding naked in various places around the house. Dr. Walker said that Gordon was not to bathe the children, but for almost every visit, Lily tells me he bathes them. She also told me twice that he let her sit on his lap and drive the car on a busy street to the Grand America Hotel where they always stay.
91. After this last visit over Thanksgiving, they again returned exhausted, Lily holding a handful of money, Caleb eating a bag of candy. Lily's hair was tangled. She told me it hadn't been combed for three days. She said she had Froot Loops for lunch and for dinner. She said he hadn't brushed her teeth in four days since she left home. When I dropped her off Thursday morning, she still had a fever of about 100.6. I told Gordon and Renaissance in a note that her fever the night before had been 103.5. I dropped her off in her pajamas because she was sick and didn't want to get dressed. She said she did not get a nap, nor did Caleb for those three days, even though both (I came to pick them up Thursday night at 7:00 p.m. and was told that the attorneys had arranged for them to have three overnights instead of the usual one overnight per visit. My attorney said he discussed it with me after court on November 20. I did not remember it. I sent an overnight bag to the hotel the next day.
92. Commissioner Blomquist intends to establish standard visitation at the hearing on December 20, unless we can show a reason for it to be otherwise.
93. Heather Walker has been court ordered, after three subpoenas, to deliver her documents with all the test data.
94. There is another hearing scheduled for Renaissance on November 30.

Craig Romney Interview 9 Apr 08
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I was able to reach Craig Romney at McGarryBowen, 212 598 2900, at 2 pm eastern time. (See photo, at right, with his son.)

After the interview I concluded he would not be a significant witness either for or against Barbara Bowen's attempt to get full custody. He knows Gordon is involved in a divorce action but has not discussed it with him. He said he preferred to stay out of it and not get involved. Nevertheless he was cooperative and answered all of my questions.

He interned at McGarryBowen the summer of 2003, for two months, before graduating from BYU in 2005. Romney worked for mcgarrybowen as a freelance music producer for a couple of years.

He said Eric and Collin were there that summer. "Good kids," he called them. He said each of them had his own bedroom although Craig slept on sort of a foldout bed in a sort of half room as he described it. He said other visitors would stay over from time to time but he didn't recall who they were. Craig later said he was not aware of Gordon, at any time, trying to get an adult male into his bed.

He did not talk religion much with Gordon.

I asked him what Gordon's sexual orientation is. "Homosexual," he said without pausing.

Craig said he did not know it at the time but learned it since through discussions and observing Gordon's mannerisms. He was also unaware, that summer that Gordon had been excommunicated a few months earlier. (lp: Did Colin and Eric know at that point?)

He had not heard the names Mel Fish and David Hamblin. (I think it was later that Hamblin was in New York.) Knew nothing about the casting out of spirits. ✓

He said Gordon's strength is the ability to connect emotionally to a brand in a 30-60 second time capsule. He said Gordon worked "unofficially" on his dad's campaigns, being available for advice, etc.

One web blog wrote the following about that:

There's a big feature today in The New York Times today about presidential candidate Mitt Romney's advertising strategy—of spending a lot of money early so that his national reputation can catch up (and in some cases surpass) those of his better known rivals. What the story doesn't mention is that one person allegedly working on the campaign is Gordon Bowen, now, of course, of mcgarrybowen, but probably better known for working on the Coke business at McCann-Erickson in the 1990s when the brand had its bizarre flirtation with Michael Ovitz and CAA. Note I said allegedly there, but even though my reporting on this is limited to a few reliable sources and some strategic searching this morning, I'd put some money on Bowen being part of Team Romney. (And, no, it's not just because Mormons—which both Bowen and Romney are—are known for sticking together.) Exhibit A: Bowen and Romney worked together on the Salt Lake City Olympics back in 2000, when Romney was president of the Games' organizing committee. In Googling Mitt Romney and Bowen, I somehow got to a post by Craig Romney on Five Brothers, the group blog of all five Romney boys, in which someone commented how he'd met Craig back in 1993 at a fundraiser at Gordon Bowen's house in SLC. It also turns out young Craig works at a New York ad agency as a music producer, but his blog doesn't say which. His MySpace page, however, does, and you guessed it—he works at mcgarrybowen.
