A Note from the Pastor

A blessed December to you all!

I don't know about you, but I am coming into the Advent and Christmas seasons with a little less pep and joy that I usually do. I'm feeling weary! In the last two months, our community has had three very unexpected deaths, plus another death that was fairly anticipated; our country has gone through a difficult election cycle; devastating wars which we wish had ended long ago, are now going into their second and third years; and its winter in Fairbanks! As much as I love winter (it's my favorite season), it does bring its own unique set of challenges: driveways to shovel ...and then re-shovel, less daylight, car batteries dying, and with a toddler, all the time spent putting on and taking off winter gear takes the same amount of time as we'll be spending outside sometimes. All of these events and circumstances are very wearying!

So, when I discovered that Kate Bowler had created an Advent Devotional called The Weary World Rejoices, I couldn't help but think of our congregation specifically. We have come out of a busy Fall with hosting Presbytery and several other big and fun Sundays, only to land in a winter season beginning with grief and unexpected loss. We're weary! Whether we feel it or not.

As such, I am grateful that Bowler has created this devotional! She's a best-selling author, a Professor of Religious History at Duke University, a mom of two, and at the age of 35 she was diagnosed with Stage IV cancer with a gruelling treatment plan and recovery. In the aftermath of her cancer, Kate has been rethinking "pretty much everything she thought she knew about life, loss, grief, and even joy." Because of this, she approaches this season of Advent and Christmas, not with a false joy or false hope, but with eyes wide open and searching for Christ amid a messy existence. Through this devotional, she invites us along that journey with her, and my hope is that this guide will help us find moments of hope, peace, love, joy, and connection as we journey towards Christ's birth together.

Because the reality is that the season of Advent is here! "It's a season that invites us into the tension of 'already' and 'not yet,' where we hold the fragile hope that everything broken will be made whole, that every sorrow will be met with joy, and that every deep longing will be filled with love. It's about finding a way to sit with

the messiness of life while still holding on to the promise of what's to come."

So "this year, we invite you to embrace the Advent and Christmas season as it is – imperfect, beautiful, and real." During this season, we'll journey through this free, individual, four-week, daily devotional together. You can access it online two ways: (1) there's a downloadable interactive PDF to read and use on your computer, tablet, or phone; or (2) there's an "online course page" (which makes it sound more intense than it actually is!) where you can access each day's devotion (you just have to "register" [with your name and email address], then "log in" each time using those same credentials). (There's also a printable PDF – it's 96 [single-sided] pages though, so if you'd like the church to print you a copy, let us know!)


This individual devotional "is made to use solo or with your family, best friend, co-worker, or partner. Each entry should take around 20 minutes, including time to read scripture, read a short devotional, reflect on thoughtful questions, and close with a blessing. Each Sunday's entry is meant to be All-Play to use with family or friends (FaceTime counts!), including time to light the Advent candle and reflect together on what you are learning."

May we, in our weary world, find ways to authentically rejoice in this season of preparation for Christ's coming. I hope you will journey with us and *The Weary World Rejoices*!

A New Permanent Fund—for UCPC!



From the Presbyterian Foundation:

To grow the fund and ensure it provides stable and maximum funding for your ministry today and into the future, the Presbyterian Foundation will reinvest the first four quarters of net income back into principal of the account. At the end of the fifth Quarter period, March 31, 2026, the net income will be calculated based on the Spending Formula adopted by the Foundation and sent directly to [UCPC's] bank account around April 20, 2026. There are no restrictions on how to use the income.



Motion was **APPROVED** with no opposition.

Orders of the Day (7 p.m.)

Deacons' report. Carol gave the deacons' report. Deacons were thanked for their good and loving service.

Comments from the Congregation.

No written comments were received from the congregation.

The church received a letter from the Presbyterian Foundation notifying UCPC that an **endowment grant of more than \$25,000 was created by a church family donor to benefit UCPC**. The letter includes ways by which others can add to the endowment fund to create a lasting legacy to benefit the mission of UCPC.

Muffie Durst spoke to the session in person about the following:

What it means to be the contact person with the Red Cross for using UCPC as a red cross shelter. Muffie is the contact person, but is often out of town. Session agreed that Roger and Joe will be added as Red Cross contacts.

Ideas that the Mission Committee has to reach beyond our walls to new people.

Notification of church members when the death of a church member occurs.

Clerk's Report. Doreen read the clerk's report and it was discussed.

New Business:

It was moved and seconded to transfer Will Haight's membership to First United Presbyterian Church

in Loveland CO, at his request. Motion was APPROVED with no opposition.

- Worship Committee moves that the UCPC guest preacher honorarium rate be increased to \$250 per sermon, or \$1,200 for a contiguous four-week block. Motion was APPROVED with no opposition.
- Worship Committee moves that a single worship service be held on Christmas Eve (Tue Dec 24) this year, beginning at 8:30 p.m. Motion was APPROVED with no opposition.
- Finance Committee moves that UCPC sign the engagement letter with Yukon Accounting and Consulting to continue with preparation and submission of federal tax forms relating to taxes withheld. Motion was APPROVED with no opposition.
- We discussed an Epiphany party with New Hope & Korean Presbyterian churches. We agreed that **Doreen will contact First Korean and Erika will contact New Hope** to find out if there is interest and whether they have ideas about what such a party would look like.
- West Valley High School's request to use facilities for overnight use. It was moved and seconded to approve overnight use of church facilities by visiting school groups -- if the schedule works for UCPC and its current renters. UCPC requires that all groups be closely supervised and certain areas (including the sanctuary, conference room, office, music room, mechanical room, and electrical room) are off-limits. Motion was APPROVED with no opposition.

Training date for New Elders and Deacons. It was agreed to **TABLE** this item.

Procedures to notify members when there's a death in our church family. After much discussion, **Rog**er agreed to make a small card asking congregants to fill in the method by which they prefer to be notified in case of an urgent church event, such as cancellation of worship due to weather or the death of a church family member.

Old Business

General Assembly (GA) booklets. It was moved and seconded to provide to the congregation a brief paper created by another Presbytery that lists the proposed Constitutional Amendments, with a link to the full booklet of the exact wording and discussion of each proposed amendment. Motion was APPROVED with no opposition.
