A Note from the Pastor

Lately, our household has been watching a lot of lighting and thunder kids' science videos on YouTube. Although Ottilie has experienced thunder before this summer, the past month has been the first time she's really experienced it and felt some fear. It's been fascinating to start seeing her making connections between delayed cause and effect – first thunder and lightning storm, then smoke from fires.

Psalm 29's third, fourth and seventh verses offer us the imagery of thunder and lightning as God's voice:

³The voice of the Lord is over the waters; the God of glory thunders, the Lord thunders over the mighty waters.

⁴The voice of the Lord is powerful; the voice of the Lord is majestic.

⁷The voice of the Lord strikes with flashes of lightning.

The reverberating of thunder in the air in the wake of a bolt of lightning is both exhilarating and terrifying. I love thinking of this powerful sound as one of the sounds of God's voice. It reminds me of the range of who all God is. God is God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, with the expansive range of expressions contained in that Trinity. And, God is loud, strong, quiet, still, slow, quick, jealous, angry, protective, creative, loving, blindingly bright, and much more.

The loudness of thunder, earthquakes, fireworks, and other big booms, can remind us that God is much larger than we are. Yet, despite God's overwhelming and overpowering size, God chose to become a tiny, weak, human infant in order to save the world. So, can the grandeur of an electrical storm invite us to hear God's voice in small and soft sounds as well? Can we hear God's voice in the skittering of a vole in the garage, the soft breaths of a family member's sleep, the scraping of a spoon scooping up cookie dough in a quiet kitchen, or the rustling of wind in the leaves of a tree?

This month, if we hear more thunder or any fireworks;* if we hear voles or the wind in the leaves, I pray that we hear them as God's voice, reminding us that God is greater than we are; yet also, simultaneously small enough to be present in each and every atom of this world.

It was moved and seconded to **amend** the consent agenda to remove the May minutes for further discussion later in the meeting. Motion was APPROVED; final motion was **APPROVED** by a vote of 7:0.

Orders of the Day (7 p.m.)

Deacons' report. Sarah Lanstra gave the Deacons report, including the attached written report and report of health concerns in the congregation. Deacons were thanked for their tireless work.

Comments from the Congregation (none received)

Clerk's Report

New Business:

Minutes of the May 15, 2025 session meeting were amended and **APPROVED** by a vote of 7:0. Further discussion of committee reports:

Fellowship. Many events transpired in the last month, including a potluck with the Wisconsin mission group, graduation recognition, and worship on the porch and potluck. Session discussed the status of bulletin board update. Marji will be unable to work on this until after harvest.

Building Stewards. In addition to work noted in the Building Stewards report, session discussed concern about more trees falling and damaging property. Two large spruce fell this week in a wind storm, sparking the discussion and request that Building Stewards look into

the problem created by these aging trees.

Wedding Policy. Pastor Erika is working on updating UCPC's very old wedding policy and will give the draft to session when it is ready.

Motion from Finance and Stewardship Committee: the final motion, as amended was APPROVED by a vote of 7:0: To expend up to \$3,000 in 2025 and \$3,000 in 2026 from the Youth Activities Designated Giving account to provide scholarship and transportation to Bingle Camp for campers.

Old Business

It was moved and seconded to **ratify the email vote to authorize communion at Lily Miller's memorial service on June 5.** Motion was **APPROVED** by a vote of 7:0

It was moved and seconded to **count an email vote of session as a valid session vote without having to ratify it at a later session meeting.** Motion was **APPROVED** by a vote of 7:0.

Following are the Clerk's proposed Rules for such an email vote will mirror rules of the Presbytery of Yukon, as follows:

The Session of UCPC may use e-mail to act on non-controversial or time critical motions.

The moderator or clerk shall notify each member by electronic mail (if a person has regular, easy access to email), or by telephone, fax, or U.S. mail of the proposed motion. The notification shall include the complete wording of the motion, pertinent information, and deadline for responding back to the moderator.

The moderator shall use discretion when relaying confidential information. Confidential information shall be sent via U.S. mail if a member does not have sole access to his/her email account or fax messages are accessible by anyone other than the member.

Quorum shall be one-half of the session members.

If a member objects to the matter being presented or decided or wants to discuss the matter in detail, a special meeting (with simultaneous aural communication) shall be called to discuss and act on the motion.

Voting: A minimum of 3 days shall be permitted to complete voting.

Passage of a motion requires a unanimous vote, provided there is a quorum. If the number of members voting does not constitute a quorum, or if the votes on the motion are not unanimous, the motion shall be discussed at a meeting.

Any actions taken by this process shall be recorded in the minutes of the next meeting of the Session with a notation that the action was taken by electronic vote.

Communion at future funerals at UCPC. It was moved and seconded that the **session authorize communion at funerals/memorials at UCPC, if requested by the family.** Motion was **APPROVED** by a vote of 7:0

Sanctified Imagination and completion of the Mission Study. We received 10 responses to the sanctified Imagination questions so far. Jim will continue to request these during the next two Sundays and then consolidate them.

Pastor Erika's Contract. A typographical error was corrected. The contract will be ready for signatures and Presbytery of Yukon approval once the Lutheran bishop's approval is received.

Administrative Assistant and Organist pay. This item was postponed to the July meeting, pending additional information.

Book: Pastor and People, Making Mutual Ministry Work. The session has 4 copies of this book. Roger, Paula, Pat and Doreen will begin reading and pass the book on to other session members.



2 Corinthians 3:1
