

A Note from the Pastor

The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love. - Psalm 103:8

Gosh, does it feel good to get dirt under my fingernails again! But resuming gardening reminds me just how much more patient God is, compared to me (or any other finite being for that matter).

For example: recently, Ottilie (who is 3) was helping me transfer our vegetable starts into the ground. As she was "digging" holes in the soil, she was really just flinging fistfuls of dirt in every direction (much of it landing on me — in my eyes, hair, nose, pockets). I wish I could say that I responded with the same calm demeanor I possess when she asks for a banana or a cookie in the middle of a sermon. But alas, I cannot. I snapped, let my anger get the better of me, huffed with impatient sighs, and all around just wasn't the kind of calm, cool, collected, and grace-filled parent I try to be.

Thankfully though, Ollie and I aren't the only parents Ottilie has. She also has another parent: God, who sees her attempts at digging holes in a garden as something to be celebrated and worked with or through, rather than something to be put up with or exasperated by. This reality – of having a third parent – is true for you and I as well. Just like Ottilie, we will attempt many things – we will try to be helpful – and also just like Ottilie, we will not always succeed. But God still sees our attempts and our effort through a lens of love. God will love us because of our attempts and despite them.

God does not ask or expect perfection or grandness of service from us. God does ask that we strive to perfectly keep the law though. We inevitably cannot however, so Christ has done that for us on the cross, and now we participate in Christ's perfection – to try, to show up and put effort in, and to communicate through intentions and actions that we love God and are committed to being in relationship with God.

So next time you're digging holes or doing something else in an attempt to be helpful, but it feels like you're failing or falling down on the job, know that yes, you might be! BUT "success" versus "failure" is not how God's love is earned or achieved. Rather, God's love is manifested in our willingness to say "yes" to participating in God's love in the wake of Jesus' action on your behalf. God sees your "yes" and loves it, rather than seeing your failure and snapping at you or huffing in exasperation. God sees your efforts and works with and through them in sometimes incredibly creative and imaginative ways to achieve God's desired outcome. Your "yes" to God – even if the execution of your "yes" flops – still glorifies and gives praise to God.

To God — who is eternally patient, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love – be the glory! Amen.

Scripture and Devotion Matthew Bierer gave a devotion based on Proverbs 3:5–6 and Proverbs 19:20

A quorum was declared

The amended Consent Agenda was ADOPTED with no opposition

Docket

Minutes of the April 18, 2024 Session meeting

Receipt of written reports from committees, Deacons and the Pastor, with the amendment that the Pastor's and Building Stewards' reports were moved to new business for further discussion.

Orders of the Day (7 p.m.)

Deacons' report was given by Judy Fowler-Morris. In addition to the written report, prayers were asked for members, including a youngster bitten by a dog. The deacons were thanked for their tireless service.

Comments from the Congregation. There were no verbal or written comments received by the Clerk.

Clerk's Report was given by Doreen McNeill.

New Business:

Pastor's report. In addition to the written report, Pastor Erika shared that

offering the Sacraments is a vital function of pastoring and she is lamenting not offering the Sacraments more often. The session agreed to consider ways that can be done. To start, the Worship Committee will conduct a straw poll of the congregation regarding the number of times communion is regularly offered during worship. The session recognizes that the congregation elected Session members to make this decision, but understanding the needs and desires of congregants is useful in making this decision. Worship committee will further explore this topic.

Pastor Erika will attend a continuing education conference in Minnesota during July 29–31. The conference is fully funded, so costs UCPC nothing. Executive Presbyter, Rev. Elizabeth Schultz will preach that Sunday and meet with the congregation.

Building Stewards report. In addition to the written report, Joe noted that the Borough's contractor that was going to clean up Lutke Ave (the raised area behind the church parking lot) has backed out. So, this clean-up is on hold. Joe continues to work with UAF and AT&T to push them to clean up the garbage on their adjacent property.

Based on a second request received from the Alaska Spay and Neuter Assistance Program (ASNAP), it was moved and seconded to approve ASNAP to conduct these surgery clinics once a month at UCPC. Motion FAILED by a vote of 0:6. In addition to concerns about building security, sanitation, and concern for other building users, Session noted that this type of activity does not meet our mission statement. Joe Krizek responded to ASNAP.

The May 19 potluck was discussed and assignments made for the mission study activity.

Questions of the Month. Elders were given assignments to summarize the *Questions of the Week* that were handed out during worship. The summaries will be handed out at the June 9 mission study potluck. Summary assignments are as follows:

Transitional Mission Study work was discussed. Doreen used Rev. James' study design to create questions for the May 19 potluck mission study. Rev. James sent specific study designs for the June 9 and Sept. 8 potluck mission studies. These will be discussed at the May 23 meeting with Rev. James. The contact with our consultant will go on hiatus while Rev. James undergoes surgery and treatment for breast cancer. Prayers were asked for Rev. James.

Mission Committee. It was agreed that **Matthew Bierer will be the liaison with Mission Committee**, which is functioning without a session member on that committee.



The window project construction start date will be in June and completion will be in July. Exact day and time depends on when the windows are received from the supplier.
