Liturgy:

-October is the month of the Most Holy Rosary. The Rosary, a special prayer to the Blessed Virgin Mary, is prayed before most Masses at St. Bonaventure Church, especially on the weekends. Saturdays, the Rosary begins at 330pm (Oct 7 in support of the Rosary Coast to Coast Rally in Washington D.C.); Sunday, it begins at 1020am. This year at 7pm on the evenings of October 9-13, there will be special devotions to Our Lady and the Most Holy Eucharist. It will include hymns, the scriptural Rosary and prayers to Our Lady. Fr. Paschal will be attending the priest institute, so there will be no Masses during the week. On Thursday, October 12, a Rosary walk will include Fr. McCartan students. In addition to Saturday, Oct 14, at noon, at the grotto behind school, the Rosary will be recited under the title, "The Rosary for America". Please join us at any or all events as we pray the Rosary for our nation, our parish, Fr. Paschal, and our community.

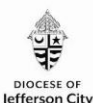
