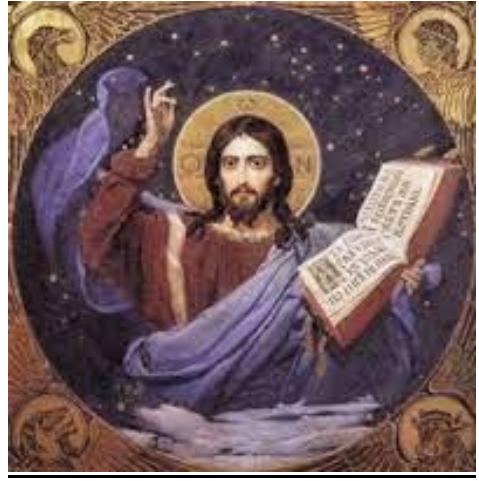
Day of Adoration: First Friday from 815am Mass until 7pm
