Holy Day of Obligation There are only 5 days out of the year in addition to Sundays when we are obliged to attend Mass in the Diocese of Jefferson City. January 1, the feast of the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, is one of them. The others are August 15, The Assumption of Mary; November 1, All Saints; December 8, The Immaculate Conception; and December 25, Christmas. Mass times for the Solemnity of Mary are on Monday evening, December 31 at 5:30 pm and on New Year's Day at 8:00 am. Mass at Brookfield is at 9:30 am. What better way to end the old year and begin a new year than by going to Mass and receiving the Eucharist!

Day of Adoration is Friday, January 4, beginning with Mass and Benediction at 8:05 am and ending with Mass on Saturday, January 5 at 7:30 am. Opportunities for confession are at 3:30 and 6:30 pm on Friday (until all are heard) and at 6:45 am on Saturday until Mass time. It may be cold outside, but spending time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament will warm your heart! He is waiting for us to Come and Adore! Maybe a good New Year's resolution is to attend Mass on Adoration Days or spend time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.
