Grateful Living: Last week was the start of grateful living. If you did not have a chance to start it yet but would like to, it would be very easy to catch up and do two lessons this week. There are now 5 weeks left for this season.

Last weeks session reflected on the healing of the blind man Bartimaeus, including this passage: *"We need to see life clearly, unimpeded by the distractions that so often block our view. We need vision – to see with eyes of wonder and awe, to perceive Jesus, our savior and brother, who walks with us, while seeing all we need to do in order to share Christ's love in the world"* I ask you, in what ways do you need clearer vision of Jesus and his place in your life? What would help you achieve that goal?

This weeks session will reflect on the fact that we are made in the image of God, included is this passage: *"A spirituality of stewardship invites us to recognize that God calls all of creation good. We who are created in God's image are called to reflect this goodness in the world"* How do you reflect God's goodness in the world around you? What else could you do?
